RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE DECEMBER 18, 2015 “WEST MIAMI MIDDLE SCHOOL – GREEN AND GOLD ANNUAL FOOTBALL GAME” SPONSORED BY WEST MIAMI MIDDLE SCHOOL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,420.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 6 FY 2015-16 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the “West Miami Middle School – Green and Gold Annual Football Game” is a small event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$2,420.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 6 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve funds,


