

RESOLUTION NO. R-548-16

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW
122ND AVENUE BETWEEN SW 42ND STREET AND SW
26TH STREET AS "RODGER B. IRVINE SR. WAY"

WHEREAS, for over 50 years, Rodger B. Irvine Sr., a Miami Senior High School graduate and Baseball Hall of Fame inductee who went on to play professional baseball with the Pittsburgh Pirates, was an inspiring presence in the Village Green community of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Rodger selflessly dedicated himself to educating, mentoring and coaching generations of athletes in Miami-Dade County through his involvement with the YMCA, the Village Green Country Club, and various community schools; and

WHEREAS, Rodger was also a loving husband, father, and grandfather, as well as a loyal friend and community leader, whose warmth and passion for sports and music lifted everyone around him; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2016, Rodger passed away; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Rodger B. Irvine Sr. and his dedicated service to Village Green by codesignating a street in that community—that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 42nd Street and SW 26th Street—as "Rodger B. Irvine Sr. Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 42nd Street and SW 26th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 122nd Avenue between SW 42nd Street and SW 26th Street as “Rodger B. Irvine Sr. Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Daniella Levine Cava**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
