



RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE “OLYMPIC PARK WEST END HOLIDAY” EVENTS HELD BETWEEN NOVEMBER 2015 AND JANUARY 2016 SPONSORED BY COMMISSIONER JUAN C. ZAPATA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,076.72 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 11 FY 2015-16 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Commissioner Juan C. Zapata has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the “Olympic Park West End Holiday” events held between November 2015 and January 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$4,076.72; and

WHEREAS, the “Olympic Park West End Holiday” events are a series of community events allowing area residents to celebrate the holiday season and come together; and

WHEREAS, the “Olympic Park West End Holiday” events are district events, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$4,076.72 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 11 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the “Olympic Park West End Holiday” events held between November 2015 and January 2016 sponsored by Commissioner Juan C. Zapata, in an amount not to exceed \$4,076.72 to be funded from the balance of the District 11 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve Fund.

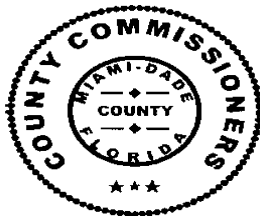
