

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 1, 2016 "SPRING FESTIVAL" SPONSORED BY THE PTA FLORIDA CONGRESS D/B/A SOUTHWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOL PTSA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 8 FY 2015-16 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the PTA Florida Congress d/b/a Southwood Middle School PTSA has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the April 1, 2016 "Spring Festival" event in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the "Spring Festival" is a fundraiser for the Southwood Middle School PTSA, which features a family-friendly event including, among other things, student performances; and

WHEREAS, the PTA Florida Congress d/b/a Southwood Middle School PTSA is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the "Spring Festival" is a small event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$1,000.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 8 FY 2015-16 In-Kind Reserve funds,
