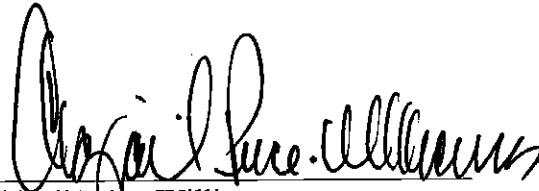

RESOLUTION NO. R-1100-19

RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO CODESIGNATE THAT PORTION OF STATE ROAD 90/SW 8TH STREET FROM SW 12TH AVENUE TO SW 14TH AVENUE "ROSA MARIA PLASENCIA WAY"; URGING THE CITY OF MIAMI TO JOIN IN URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE; APPROVING SUCH CODESIGNATION

**WHEREAS**, in October, 2018, Rosa Maria Plasencia passed away at age 59; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosa Maria Plasencia was the President and Chief Executive Officer of Amigos for Kids, a local not-for-profit dedicated to ending child abuse in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosa Maria Plasencia spent decades working to improve the lives of children in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, under her tenure, Amigos for Kids was named by The Children's Trust Program as program of the year, and Amigos for Kids saw tremendous growth and reached over 2,5000 elementary school students through its child abuse awareness education; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosa Maria Plasencia served as the chair of the Eleventh Circuit Task Force for the State of Florida Child Abuse Prevention and Permanency Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2017, Rosa Maria Plasencia was inducted into the Miami-Dade College Hall of Fame; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosa Maria Plasencia impacted the lives of thousands of children through various programs including the beloved Amigos for Kids Holiday Toy Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, Rosa Maria Plasencia dedicated her life to the protection and betterment of children throughout the County; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board would like to honor the memory of Rosa Maria Plasencia by urging the Florida Legislature to codesignate that portion of State Road 90/SW 8th Street from 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue “Rosa Maria Plasencia Way”; and

**WHEREAS**, SW 8th Street from 12th Avenue and SW 14th Avenue is a state road within the City of Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, because SW 8th Street is a state road, the Florida Legislature would be required to codesignate this road; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the erection of markers for a state road codesignation shall be contingent upon the appropriate city or county commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary designation; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

**Section 1.** Urges the Florida Legislature to codesignate that portion of State Road 90/SW 8th Street from 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue “Rosa Maria Plasencia Way”.

**Section 2.** Urges the City of Miami to join in urging the Florida Legislature to codesignate that portion of State Road 90/ SW 8th Street from 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue “Rosa Maria Plasencia Way”.

**Section 3.** Approves the state road codesignation of that portion of SW 8th Street from 12th Avenue to SW 14th Avenue “Rosa Maria Plasencia Way”.

**Section 4.** Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation, the Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department, and the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department.

**Section 5.** Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the action set forth in Section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2020 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Co-Prime Sponsors of the foregoing resolution are Vice Chairwoman Rebeca Sosa and Commissioner Eileen Higgins. It was offered by Commissioner **Esteban L. Bovo, Jr.**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

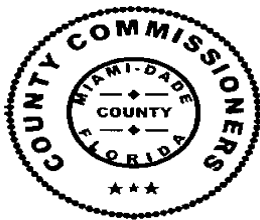
