



RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-1090-19

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A REPORT SETTING FORTH PROPOSED METHODS FOR PROTECTION OF TRANSIT PATRONS AT BUS STOPS OR BUS SHELTERS WITH RESPECT TO FUTURE INSTALLATIONS OF SAME AND TO SUBMIT A REPORT WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 14-65

WHEREAS, additional bus shelters are scheduled to be installed in unincorporated Miami-Dade County within the next year; and

WHEREAS, cost effective protective measures should be incorporated wherever possible into the design of such shelters, in order to protect transit patrons from errant vehicles leaving the roadway; and

WHEREAS, due to a number of accidents involving transit patrons waiting at bus stops, in 2007, pursuant to Resolution No. R-282-07, a feasibility study was prepared at this Board's direction which recommended against the installation of bollards, but stated that the administration would continue to explore other cost-effective measures to assist in the protection of transit patrons,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board incorporates and approves the foregoing recitals as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to prepare a report setting forth the proposed schedule and location for the installation of bus shelters in the upcoming year, and to identify any proposed safety design measures to be implemented in connection with such installations in order to protect transit patrons from errant vehicles leaving the roadway.

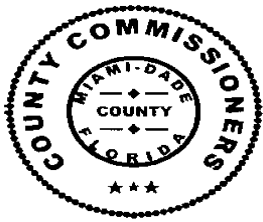
Section 3. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to provide such report directly to this Board within ~~[[60]]~~¹ >>90<< days of the effective date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
