RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD'S CODESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF SW 187TH COURT BETWEEN SW 326TH STREET AND SW 328TH STREET AS "EVERETT SEWER COURT"

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2022, the City of Homestead Council passed Resolution No. R2022-04-23, which codesignated a portion of SW 187th Court between SW 326th Street and SW 328th Street "Everett Sewer Court" to recognize and honor the contributions Mr. Everett Sewer made to the Homestead community and West Homestead K-8 Center in particular; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. R2022-04-23 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 187th Court identified by the City of Homestead is located in the City of Homestead; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 9; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Mr. Everett Sewer by approving the City of Homestead's codesignation of that portion of 187th Court between SW 326th Street and SW 328th Street as "Everett Sewer Court",

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Homestead's codesignation of a portion of SW 187th Court between SW 326th Street and SW 328th Street "Everett Sewer Court".

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RENAMING OR CO-DESIGNATING SW 187th COURT AS "EVERETT SEWER COURT"; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
