RESOLUTION NO. **R-1049-22**

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-393-22 TO
RENAME, INSTEAD OF CODESIGNATE, THAT PORTION OF
BLUE LAGOON DRIVE FROM NW 65TH AVENUE TO ITS
EASTERN TERMINUS AT THEORETICAL NW 52ND
AVENUE AS “WATERFORD DISTRICT DRIVE”

WHEREAS, at the November 1, 2022 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made to amend Resolution No. R-393-22 to rename, instead of codesignate, that portion of Blue Lagoon Drive from NW 65th Avenue to its eastern terminus at theoretical NW 52nd Avenue as “Waterford District Drive”, and to suspend Rule 9.02(a) of the Board’s Rules of Procedure requiring that this matter be considered at a public hearing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

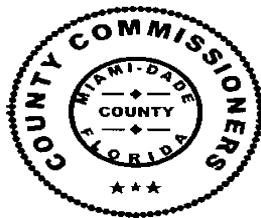
Section 1. Suspends Rule 9.02(a) of the Board’s Rules of Procedure by a two-thirds vote of Board members present and amends Resolution No. R-393-22 to rename, instead of codesignate, that portion of Blue Lagoon Drive from NW 65th Avenue to its eastern terminus at theoretical NW 52nd Avenue as “Waterford District Drive”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Oliver G. Gilbert, III and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
