Re: **Budget Conference Procedures and Dates**

As the Chairman of the Budget Conference Committee, I am requesting through the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, an approved list of priorities set by each commission committee. Such a list from each committee will set the parameters for negotiation with the administration at the budget conference meetings. This will avoid having the 5 conference committee members saying 5 different things about a committee's priorities. I believe that the conference committee members should focus on the committee approved priorities and not each individual's personal priorities.

It should be noted that the administration through its budget proposals have established its recommended priorities. The committees have had a chance to review the administrations recommendations and thus far have not objected to the vast majority of them. However, there are significant areas of the budget that each committee has identified as priorities not addressed by the administration, which will be the subject of the conference committee's negotiations.

Through the negotiation process, those priorities that we cannot reach agreement on, will be brought back to the full Board on September 20, 2007 at the final Budget Hearing for action by the commission.

I have targeted the following dates for negotiations, which are scheduled after upcoming committee meetings where unresolved priorities can be set by the committees of jurisdiction:

Friday September 14, 2007 @ 2:00 p.m.
Monday September 17, 2007 @ 2:00 p.m.
Wednesday September 19, 2007 @ 10:00 a.m.

I believe that each of these dates is crucial and required if we are to carry out our mandate. I am asking that each of the commission appointees and the administration commit to these 3 days to resolve our differences.

Thank you for your consideration in these matters.

This is nothing new, except that it was exposed by The Miami Herald soon after the even worse housing-authority debacle came to light.



Pay commissioners well,
but allow no outside jobs

The Miami-Dade County Commission goes on and on, scandal after scandal. In business CEOs go to jail. Our commissioner-CEOs keep quiet, call for change that never happens, find an excuse for themselves or find someone to take the blame, such as our most recent blamee, Roger Carlton, an able assistant county manager who exited with the failed Poinciana Park project.

Commissioners benefit from airport contracts. Commissioners take expensive gifts such as sweetheart deals on building lots from those who come before the commission. Commissioners have jobs with social service organizations that the commission funds. Guess who head these organizations, which they themselves support through public money? They earn big salaries, upwards of \$180,000. Some commissioners have had phantom jobs with the Miami-Dade Public Schools.

Even after giving \$826 million to consultants in 2006, the commission is looking for ways to save money because of budget restraints passed by the state.

I would happily stand before the commission and tell its members in person. I am forbidden. In Miami-Dade County, as in Cuba and other dictatorships, the government can pick and choose who may speak before it. During the monthly public hearing citizens' presentations, in order to speak a resident must get permission of his or her commissioner.

We need a charter change. The public must be allowed to speak as before any other public body. Being a commissioner should be a fulltime job that allows nothing on the side. I propose a salary of \$125,000 for the first term, rising to \$150,000 for future terms.

Commissioners would not be allowed to act as lobbyists for five years after they leave office.

People in office must not be allowed to continually enrich themselves at the public's expense.

POTENTIAL ANNUAL IMPACT OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FUNDING CUT:

If Miami-Dade County determines to reduce their contribution to the SFRTA/Tri-Rail by \$207,000, the following impacts would be expected annually:

- Broward and Palm Beach counties would reduce their contributions by \$414,000.
- Total contribution cuts from counties would equal \$621,000.
- The Florida Department of Transportation would reduce their matching contribution by an equal amount.
- Conservative figure for SFRTA revenue loss is estimated at \$345,412.

Total annual loss for the SFRTA/Tri-Rail would conservatively equal \$1.6 million.

TIMELINE FOR IMPLEMENTING BUDGETARY IMPACTS:

- Current contracts require 60-day notice to implement change in number of trains.
- Board and federal requirements mandate public hearings and a 30-day notification prior to any reduction in service.
- Service cuts could not go into effect until January 1, 2008.

The SFRTA annual adjustment would need to be in excess of \$3 million, with a minimum service disruption loss of 12% to a maximum service disruption loss of 48% depending upon when funding cuts are implemented, and the number of months over which they would need to be absorbed.

SUMMARY OF ADMINISTRATIVE CUTS WHICH WOULD BE IMPLEMENTED IMMEDIATELY:

- Personnel Services: \$562,386 (6.01%)
- General & Administrative Expenses: \$229,359 (10.06%)
- Marketing Expenses: \$105,000 (10.27%)
- Professional Fees: \$150,000 (10.85%)

SFRTA administrative cuts would total \$1,046,745. Only other possible cuts would have to come from service reductions.

ISSUES TO CONSIDER:

The SFRTA/Tri-Rail would be cutting service:

- At a time when we are leading the nation in ridership growth in the commuter rail sector (American Public Transportation Association).
- Below the baseline 48 trains mandated by our Full Funding Grant Agreement, which included achieving 20-minute headways during peak hours.

Tri-Rail's ridership has grown by 35% in the past 14 months and continues to show upward movement.

ADDITIONAL CUTS:

Any additional cuts needed in January 2008, must be absorbed in train operations, including the number of trains per day, with corresponding reductions in fuel and security.

Dear Mayor Alvarez:

The Board of Directors of the Miami-Dade County Community Action Agency (CAA) are writing to urge you to reconsider the current proposal to consolidate our Agency with the Department of Human Services. These two entities are slated to be combined to create the new Department of Community Services. **We strongly oppose such a merger.**

From a historical perspective, the Community Action Agency is a grass-roots organization, established over 40 years ago to address issues of poverty and its attending consequences. Since that time, hundreds of thousands of families have been able to successfully make the transition from poverty to self-sufficiency as a result of accessing vital social services offered through CAA. Additionally, the lives of a considerable number of elderly persons have been significantly enriched and sustained through programs administered by CAA. The Community Action Agency is a part of a national network of over 1,000 similar agencies that have their genesis through the passage of the 1964 Economic Opportunity Act. Under this federal designation, CAA is able to receive funds to support its early childhood education, elderly services, job training, employment placement, family development, energy conservation and emergency assistance initiatives.

As a Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) recipient, the department has a governing board that consists of a tripartite arrangement of democratically elected representatives of economically disadvantaged individuals, families and communities, locally elected public officials and representatives from business, industry, labor, religious, social welfare and other private groups in the community.

Serving as a community-based social service entity, and by providing an opportunity for economically disadvantaged citizens to have a voice in their affairs of the communities, CAA has established a credible reputation and an impressive demonstrated 40-year history of impacting economically disadvantaged persons and communities. As concerned CAA Board members and stakeholders of this community, we firmly believe that addressing the budgetary constraints of the County requires a shared spirit of sacrifice.

However, because of the potential effect upon our delivery of services to clients, our diminished connection with the community and our constrained capacity to attract additional grants and resources, we are adamantly opposed to the proposal to merge CAA with DHS.

In the past several decades, there have been studies conducted to assess the merits of merging both CAA and DHS into one central department. The studies have revealed that while some programs were complementary in nature, the uniqueness of both departments and their efforts did not result in duplication of services. **The studies also indicated that any potential savings from a proposed merger would be negligible.** As a department that derives the majority of its \$84 million dollar budget from federal and state grants, we take great pride in being able to successfully leverage \$11.9 million dollars of County general funding to administer valuable programs that enhance the quality-of-life for children, economically disadvantaged families and the elderly of this community. The return on investment for Miami-Dade County is considerable in this regard. **We strongly believe that the merger of the two departments will adversely affect our ability to continue to secure such future federal and state resources.**

We look forward to working collaboratively with you on these matters of great concern.





President George W. Bush has asked me to thank you for your letter concerning the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Program and to respond directly to you.

The CSBG is one of 35 programs operated by 7 Federal agencies to fund community and economic development. A review by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) found that many of these programs are duplicative, lack clear goals and accountability measures and cannot sufficiently demonstrate their impact on the nation's distressed communities. As you may know, the CSBG program received a rating of "Results Not Demonstrated" in the 2005 OMB review.

Consolidation of the CSBG program into the Administration's Strengthening America's Communities Initiative is part of the President's Fiscal Year 2006 budget proposal to focus economic and community development activities through a more targeted and unified program. The Strengthening America's Communities Initiative will make better use of taxpayer dollars by eliminating duplication, implementing rigorous accountability measures and incentives, and simplifying access to the Federal system. The goal is to create conditions for economic growth, job opportunities, and livable communities.

Thank you for taking the time to write. I hope this information is helpful to you in understanding the purpose and importance of the Strengthening America's Communities Initiative.

We, the undersigned, strongly oppose the suggested County Parks and Recreation Department budget cuts, which to **eliminate beach cleanup from South Beach's Government Cut jetty to 21st Street by at least 50%**. This \$ savings would have a tremendous detrimental effect on our beaches, one of the most important economical resou community.

The 825 miles of sandy coastline fronting the Atlantic Ocean is one of the Florida's most valuable natural resource beaches are deserving of this status because they serve several important functions: they are vital in maintaining Florida's economy, and they play an essential role in the recycling of nutrients, to which the surrounding ecosystem dependent upon in order to support its rich biodiversity.
