



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As Chairman of the Budget Conference committee, I am forwarding this memo to identify the following:

**A. Policy issues requiring Board of County Commissioners Consideration**

1. Shall the BCC create a Legislative Budget Office?
2. Shall the BCC create a Legislative Policy Reserve fund to fund commission priorities throughout the year?
3. Shall the BCC create a legislative office of Media, Communications and Protocol and include the Community Periodicals program?
4. Shall the BCC place the Office of Social & Economic Council under the BCC?
5. Shall the BCC restructure its table of organization under the Office of the Chair?
6. Shall the BCC re-establish the Department of Business Development as a stand alone department?

**B. Budget issues that need to be discussed at the 5 p.m. Budget Hearing**

1. The budget for any of the above policy issues supported by the Board.
2. The County Commissions' office budget.
3. The County Attorneys' office budget
4. The Commission Auditors' budget.

**C. Unresolved Budget Priority Issues that need to be discussed at the 5 p.m. Budget Hearing**

1. Funding the Agritech and Livestock Expo.
2. Restoring the funding for Miami-Metro Zoo Advertisement to its' current level.
3. Cutting the non-contractual light fleets in Corrections, Fire & Police by 10%.
4. Increasing food service for inmates by \$1.5 million rather than \$3.0 million.

**D. Potential Resources to meet budget priorities (must be discussed at the 5 p.m. Budget Hearing)**

1. Reserves.
2. Self funded Medical Insurance savings.
3. Employee Fringe Benefits (*COLA, Merit, Longevity, Executive Benefits, Cars, etc. for non-union employees*).
4. Overtime and temporary worker costs.
5. Across the board or strategically targeted light fleet reductions.
6. Across the board or strategically targeted budget reductions to departments.

At the end of the Budget Conference, while I still believe that additional priorities can be addressed, the committee agreed to support the recommendations that will come forward in a change memo from the administration. It should be clear to the commission that these recommendations were agreed to without the full knowledge of all the various resources available to meet additional budget priorities.

I want to thank Vice Chairwoman Jordan, Commissioner Souto, Commissioner Rolle and Commissioner Sorenson for their dedication to the Budget Conference process. I want to thank all of the committee Chairs and members for their hard work on setting priorities. I want to thank the County Attorney, Commission Auditor, Clerk of the Board and various commission staff members who helped facilitate the process. I want to thank the Mayor and the Administration, the County Manager, the Budget Director and their staff. While we don't agree on all the issues, they were very professional and responsive during the process.

Finally, I leave you with some personal observations. We are struggling with the new Strong Mayor form of Government that we operate under and I feel that we are having some difficulty trying to come to grips with the notion that approving the county budget is our responsibility. In the future we must be in greater control of the budget process, have all of the same information that the administration has, and be prepared to fund the priorities that we the County Commission, feel are important to this community.

Prosperity Campaign

**...Connecting people to economic opportunity**

The Prosperity Campaign is a win-win-win, creating more money for low-wage workers, a more secure workforce, and more money in the local economy. The Campaign ([www.prosperitycampaign.org](http://www.prosperitycampaign.org)) connects working people to public economic benefits including the **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)**, the **Child Tax Credit**, **Food Stamps**, **KidCare** and others. It also provides **financial literacy education programs** that help households improve their standard of living so they can buy a house or a car, or put themselves or their children through college.

The Prosperity Campaign is an initiative of the Human Service Coalition in partnership with the United Way of Miami Dade, featuring 10 Prosperity Centers (community-based partner organizations) and three affiliates in Miami-Dade and Broward counties.

**Current Tax Season Numbers**

The preliminary numbers are in for this past tax season: The IRS accepted 2,419 tax returns prepared by the Prosperity Centers. The total refund amount so far is \$3.5 million. The total in EITC is \$1.5 million. Some 320 people were referred to economic benefit programs like Food Stamps and KidCare. About 2,474 were referred to asset building programs such as IDAs, banking and financial literacy.

**Local Impact**

The Prosperity Campaign serves residents where they live by offering free tax preparation and other wealth-building services at neighborhood-based centers. Since 2002, these centers have prepared **4,219 tax returns** for a total of **\$6,005,391** in federal returns, including **\$3,083,051** in EITC. Preparing these returns free of charge saved taxpayers approximately **\$421,900**, calculated at \$100 per return.

Over the past two years, **1,919** people were given individualized financial literacy assistance; **231** were referred to or assisted with home ownership programs; **899** were matched with benefits including Food Stamps, KidCare and Medicaid; **245** were matched with Individual Development Accounts; and **128** were linked with banking and savings opportunities.

Business engagement has been a pivotal component of the Campaign since its inception. More than 4,200 businesses have learned about the Prosperity Campaign via the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce e-newsletter. Hundreds of businesses have participated, enabling HSC to reach thousands of employees. In addition, HSC jointly produces the Prosperity Matters e-newsletter in collaboration with the United Way of Miami-Dade, reaching more than 5000 business owners and HR professionals.

**Countywide Impact**

Since 2002, the Prosperity Campaign has conducted a marketing campaign to encourage the public to claim the EITC and other benefits. Marketing strategies include annual kick-off events, press conferences, media spots and PSAs. The Campaign has been featured in the media, including TV channels 10, 4 and 6; the *Miami Herald* and *Sun Sentinel* newspapers; and on radio stations WLRN, 99 JAMZ, Radio Caracol, Hot 105, and Lite 101.5 FM.

This media blast has resulted in greater uptake of EITC countywide. Between 2002 and 2003, the amount of EITC claimed in Miami-Dade County increased by **\$61,242,448**, with smaller increases in subsequent years as community awareness increased. Between 2002 and 2005, an additional **\$93,735,004** in EITC dollars was brought into the county. The amount of total EITC dollars claimed in Miami-Dade County during those four years was **\$2,173,820,882**.

**Statewide Impact**

News about the Prosperity Campaign has spread throughout the state via philanthropic and leadership organizations. HSC was invited to visit numerous communities in Florida to provide information and tools necessary to start their own campaigns. There are now eight similar programs in Florida, including: Prosperity Campaign of Palm Beach; Prosperity Campaign of Hillsborough and Pinellas Counties; Extra Credit Campaign of Orlando; and Real Sense Prosperity Campaign of Jacksonville. The former Florida state treasurer launched an effort to create a statewide Prosperity Campaign. Developed with HSC's input, the bill is pending in the state legislature.

## Reform more than just the county's budget

More than 300 Miami-Dade residents showed up at County Hall last week to make their voices heard about our county budget. Most of them had valid points. The people who predicted disaster if their soup kitchens are shut down were right. The people who say they'll have to move if they continue losing money on their eight-unit rental properties were right. The people who implored the commission to trim bureaucracy were right.

The problem is that the Legislature's recent tax "reforms" have tied the hands of local governments. There's not enough space in our budget any more for all of them to be right. Even after cutting more than 1,000 county jobs, eliminating several agencies and consolidating others, Mayor Carlos Alvarez still needed to find a way to remove \$30 million from the county's budget. So he proposed cutting funding to social service agencies in half.

These agencies and programs deliver meals to home-bound seniors, prepare low-income toddlers for school and give at-risk youth a place to go in the afternoons before their parents get home from work.

The culprit is not county government. The culprit is not even state government, whose "solution" for our tax problem only wound up shifting around inequities. The problem is our tax system. Florida has one of the most regressive tax systems in the country, meaning that taxes make up a larger proportion of how poor people spend their money than of how rich people spend theirs.

As a result, cuts wind up pitting the needs of the middle class (such as small-time entrepreneurs who rent out a few apartments) against the need of the poor (such as people who rely on the services provided by community-based organizations). Left out of this equation are the rich, who seem to be doing just fine.

We lose a billion dollars a year (more than half of the current state budget shortfall) through loopholes in the corporate income tax. With that money, we could raise our per-child education spending by 10 percent. We've lost \$600 million since the tax on intangible properties (like stocks and bonds) was eliminated this past January. That amount would be enough to provide health insurance for every uninsured child in the state.

I'm not saying that rich people or businesses should pay more than the rest of us. I'm just saying that they should pay their fair share so that we are not faced every year with impossible choices.

## PROPERTY TAX RELIEF AND REFORM FACT SHEET

A Threat to Education, Health Care, and Social Services

### KEY PROVISIONS OF THE "PROPERTY TAX RELIEF AND REFORM" BALLOT MEASURE

- ❖ Constitutional roll-back and freeze of local property taxes for counties, municipalities and special districts (except schools) to 2006 levels, exclusive of new construction or property annexations.
- ❖ Mandated local property tax cuts in most cases by an additional three to nine percent (3-9%) based on state municipal averages since 2001.
- ❖ Future tax rate growth tied to growth in state personal income.  
*Exceptions granted as a result of super-majority vote of the legislature or a vote of the people.*
- ❖ Elimination of the "Save Our Homes" constitutional assessment limit adopted in 1994.
- ❖ Creation of new "Super-Homestead" and \$25,000 tangible personal property exemption for businesses.  
*Exempts 75% of the value of a home up to its first \$200,000 and 15% for the next \$300,000, or a total potential exemption of \$195,000 with a guaranteed minimum exemption of \$50,000 (\$100,000 for persons over 65). The \$500,000 cap is indexed to inflation and may also be raised by a 2/3rds vote of the legislature. In addition, the first \$25,000 of tangible personal property (business) is exempted which may also be increased by the legislature to any level at any time.*
- ❖ New assessment limits on certain property that are affordable housing and in "working waterfronts."

The cumulative impact of the "Property Tax Relief and Reform" provisions over the next five years will be to remove \$31.5 Billion in local funding for public programs with the average revenue reduction climbing to almost 19% of the current property tax by 2011-12.

### IMPACT OF THE "PROPERTY TAX RELIEF AND REFORM" BALLOT MEASURE

The ballot measure would force severe cuts in vital public services Floridians have come to rely upon.

The design of the ballot measure will create long-term problems for Florida that will leave the state unprepared for future growth. The ballot measure does not allow for any population, cost of living or qualitative adjustments in funding any other governmental services.

Because of the mandatory caps, the state's ability to make additional investments or meet its future fiscal challenges would be greatly diminished. Florida is already the lowest ten states in state expenditure rankings.

The measure will ensure that Florida will fall in areas of education, healthcare, public safety, and infrastructure improvements. Already, Florida faces great challenges. Examples include,

- state and local funding for K-12 education is 49<sup>th</sup> in the nation (Census Bureau, 2004);
- state and local funding for colleges and universities is already the lowest -50<sup>th</sup>- in the nation (Census Bureau, 2004);
- data show Florida to be among the ten most dangerous states in the country (Census Bureau, 2007)
- state and local funding to assist the state's most vulnerable populations is 37<sup>th</sup> in the nation (Census Bureau, 2004);
- access to affordable healthcare is 43<sup>rd</sup> in the country (Commonwealth Fund, 2007);
- 1/5<sup>th</sup> of Florida's bridges are rated "structurally deficient" by the US Transportation Department (FHWA, 2004); and
- Florida's drinking water infrastructure needs \$3.7 billion over the next 20 years and its wastewater infrastructure needs almost \$10 billion in upgrades (EPA, 2005).


