

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

MOTION FOR COMMISSIONER EDMONSON:

I move to amend Special Item No. 1 as follows:

- a. That the Global Interlocal Agreement be amended:

To delete Section 8 entitled Extension of Reverter; and

- b. That the resolution include:

i. a direction to the County Mayor or his designee to enforce the reverter on the property described in Exhibit D to the Global Interlocal Agreement and take any action required to vest title to such property in the County; and to prepare a proposed RFP seeking innovative proposals from developers to develop rental units for low and very low income persons (including, without limitation, qualifying Overtown residents), elderly rental units and affordable home ownership units. The proposed RFP shall be prepared and submitted to the EDHS committee within 90 days.

ii. a direction to the County Mayor and Manager to include in the proposed budgets prepared for each fiscal year commencing 2017 and ending 2030 proposed appropriations from the general fund in an aggregate amount equal to \$175 million of the [REDACTED] SEOPW CRA Increment Revenues returned to the County under re-worded Section 5(e) of the Global Interlocal Agreement for the projects listed in Exhibit E for the removal of slum and blight in Overtown and surrounding neighborhoods:

## Exhibit E

1. \$75 million for the development of affordable rental and homeownership projects in Overtown, including \$8M for the Alonzo Mourning Project;
2. \$50 million for affordable rental housing/mixed use development at the MLK Transit Village;
3. \$5 million for the revitalization of the MLK Business Center;
4. \$10 million for a Children's Learning Center at Moore Park;
5. \$10 million for the Children's Zone Project;
6. \$5 million for the Haitian Community Center;
7. \$5 million for the Mama Hattie's House Project;
8. \$5 million for the Caleb Center renovations; and
9. \$10 million for an African American Museum.

# SPORTS PALACES GIVE TAXPAYERS THE ROYAL SHAFT

Eighty percent last week; 82 percent this week.

Average the two statewide polls: 81 per cent of Florida voters oppose the notion of giving away tax breaks for professional sports arenas.

Who cares? Public opinion hardly matters when it comes to giving away the public's money to pro team owners. No sane public official would ever consider something as untidy as a referendum before assigning sizable chunk of the public treasure to a professional baseball team. It's always best to avoid those pesky voters.

The Marlins, instead, will employ lobbyists and heap lavish attention on key legislators to wrangle a \$60 million tax break out of Tallahassee. They'll try to cobble an alliance with lawmakers from Orlando, which wants a spiffier palace for their NBA team and from Daytona Beach, which wants to build a NASCAR Hall of Fame with more than a little help from state taxpayers.

The fact that these three giveaways still have a chance of making it out of the Legislature in the face of overwhelming public disapproval demonstrates how democratic notions are trumped by wealth and influence and lobbyists. Not to mention the mystique of professional sports.

Last week's Quinnipiac (Connecticut) University poll indicated 80 percent of Florida voters against the proposed sports tax rebate with 70 percent opposition among self-professed Marlins fans. Then a second poll conducted by Research 2000 for The Jacksonville Times-Union and the Sun-Sentinel, came in at 82 percent opposed.

**OVERWHELMING VOTE**

Four of every five Florida voters say no. Fidel Castro is more popular than the Marlins tax rebate. No one believes the bunk about baseball stadiums igniting urban renewal or generating jobs or convincing Fortune 500 corporations to relocate to Little Havana, hoping for shot at a luxury skybox. Yet, the rebate lives.

# **MOST VOTERS OPPOSE TAX BREAKS FOR STADIUM, POLL INDICATES**

More than 80 percent of Florida voters oppose tax breaks to help build new homes for the Florida Marlins and Orlando Magic, as well as a hall of fame for NASCAR, according to a new survey.

The general public isn't the only one opposed: Self-described fans of the Marlins, Magic and NASCAR don't favor the tax breaks, either, the poll shows. Nearly 70 percent of those who identified themselves as Marlins fans said they were opposed.

Results of the survey, conducted by Connecticut-based Quinnipiac University, were released 24 hours before today's vote by Miami-Dade County commissioners on whether to help the Marlins build a \$420 million ballpark. That nonbinding agreement, already inked by the City of Miami, will form the justification to ask the Legislature for upwards of \$60 million.

Marlins President David Samson, who called the county-city-team agreement "historic," said he couldn't comment on the poll because he didn't see how the questions were framed. The stadium coalition seeks what's called a yearly "rebate" from the state of the first \$2 million in sales tax money collected at the door. Therefore, stadium boosters argue, the tax kickback won't dip into state coffers.

"This will be generating millions and millions for the state," Samson said. "There's going to be a huge surplus."

But opponents of the financing plan have long argued that the state rebate, used by a few other teams, guarantees \$60 million over 30 years, regardless of whether any sales tax is collected. When the law was proposed in the early 1990s, it was dubbed the "Hood Robbin' Act" because critics said it took tax money from the poor and gave it to wealthy team owners.

NASCAR has asked several cities in the country whether they want to help build a Hall of Fame for the racing industry. Daytona Beach has expressed an interest and is seeking money from the state.

# FROM THE ORANGE BOWL TO THE MARLINS STADIUM: WHO BENEFITS?


A legally binding Community Benefit Agreement between the City, County and the community seeks to ensure that \$445 million of public funds slated for the Marlins baseball stadium will benefit the residents of Miami Dade County.

A Research Institute for Social and Economic Policy (RISEP) of Florida International University report analyzes the impact on Miami-Dade County of this publicly funded project.

## Who gets the jobs?

If non-local labor is hired with the public's \$445 million:

- Loss of payroll to local residents of between \$150 million and \$165.5 million.
- Loss of tax revenue for Miami-Dade County of between \$408,000 and \$734,000.
- Loss of local employment of between 3,773 and 4,191 jobs.
- Loss of local spending between \$38 million to over \$68 million.



## Best Value Contracting (BVC)

Studies comparing low-bid to BVC overwhelmingly find that BVC reduces cost growth, schedule growth, and increases customer satisfaction.

- In BVC contractors are chosen on the basis of technical merit, past performance, safety practices, local experience, worker training and price.
- BVC ensures a top quality as builders realize underperformance hurts their chances of winning future contracts.
- BVC's cooperative structures forces the early development of realistic overall project costs, dramatically reducing change orders and litigation.
- BVC contributes to the county's broader goals by improving the skills of workforce and enhancing employment opportunities for local residents and /or racial and ethnic minorities.

## Supporting local businesses

- These jobs circulate tax dollars through local neighborhoods, provide needed opportunities for growth of the minority business sector.
- Minority-owned firms tend to hire a higher percentage of local residents and minority employees.
- Hiring minority contractors shows the local government's commitment to economic development and workforce development by promoting the creation of decent jobs in minority neighborhoods



## Workforce training

- A federal GAO report proves that apprenticeships are the most successful job training programs in the U.S. today.
- The studies also indicate that use of apprentices on construction projects is efficient.
- Use of apprentices ensures that the work goes to local employees and builds a stable, skilled workforce.

## Health Care and Public Projects

- In 2004 almost 72 percent of Miami-Dade emergency room visits were by the uninsured costing over \$17 million per year charges that could be avoided if workers had reliable access to non-emergency care.
- The Jackson Health Care System spent \$508 million dollars in charity care in 2005, or \$798 per uninsured Miami-Dade county resident.
- If only half of the workers have health coverage, the estimated cost in charity care will be nearly \$1.3 million for workers alone, and almost \$3.9 million for workers and their families.
