Suggested amendments to the Taxi Ordinance that has been to the first reading.

- 1. That the 38 medallions be for wheelchair accessible taxis.
- 2. That the 38 new wheelchair taxis cannot pick up riders at the airport. They cannot get in line after dropping a fare at the airport.
- 3. That the existing 65 wheelchair taxi's owners are allowed to enter into incorporation, if they are radio equipped and have a GPS system.

4. That the new 38 medallion wheelchair accessible taxi owners shall be required to incorporate,

MA → *To have* TWO SHIFTS for these 38 new wheelchair Taxi Medallion Holders *and require them*

5. That a wheelchair taxi medallion owner, after five years of driving be allowed to lease out his license.

6. That the cap on only two wheelchair taxi medallions be eliminated.
