proposed ordinance was open for public
participation.*

*Ms. Cathy Jones, Chair, Vizcaya Museum and
Gardens Trust (Trust), One Grove Island Drive,
appeared before the Committee in support of the
foregoing proposed ordinance. She expressed
appreciation to Commissioner Rolle for
appointing her to the Trust, and to the County
Commission for its support of the Vizcaya
Museum and Gardens. Ms. Jones said this
proposed ordinance clearly demonstrated the
Commission's leadership role to support common
goals. She referenced the initial ordinance
regarding fee waivers for the use of Vizcaya
Museum and Gardens, and noted this ordinance
was amended in March 2008 to change the
requirements for Commission sponsored waivers
from a unanimous vote to a two-thirds vote of the
County Commission. Ms. Jones said at that time,
Commissioner Diaz committed to introducing the
proposed amendment before the Committee
today. She noted this proposed ordinance, co-
sponsored by Commissioner Edmonson, was
unanimously supported by the members of the
Vizcaya Museum and Gardens Trust.*

*Miami-Dade County Commissioner Jose "Pepe"
Diaz, sponsor, 8345 NW 12th Street, appeared
before the Committee in support of the foregoing
proposed ordinance.*

*Following discussion between the Committee
members and Commissioner Diaz regarding
events that were held annually, such as the
International Conference of Mayors,*

Commissioner Edmonson suggested the foregoing proposed ordinance be amended to exempt the International Conference of Mayors.

Commissioner Diaz recommended that Commissioner Edmonson's proposed amendment include any event that was significant to the County by approval of a majority vote of the County Commission.

Commissioner Rolle asked to be listed as a co-sponsor to the foregoing proposed ordinance.

In response to Commissioner Edmonson's inquiry regarding the wording of the proposed amendment, Assistant County Attorney Thomas Logue noted the word "generally" could be inserted in criteria iv. to read as follows: "Fee waivers and reductions shall not generally be granted to an organization more than once every two years ..." or this criteria could be eliminated.

Responding to Commissioner Jordan's inquiry regarding the previous policy and any potential expenditure ramifications for staffing, Assistant County Manager Alex Munoz said no current policy existed in terms of the two-year exemption. He noted organizations utilizing Vizcaya Museum and Gardens were required to pay for staffing.

Commissioner Jordan asked to be listed as a co-sponsor to the foregoing proposed ordinance.

Assistant County Attorney Logue noted a scrivener's error existed in the foregoing proposed ordinance and the word "or" in the third line of criteria vi. should be deleted.

Following discussion and pursuant to Commissioner Diaz' request, the Committee amended the foregoing proposed ordinance to provide that fee waivers and reductions may be granted at the discretion of the County Commission to an organization more than once every two years.

Hearing no further comments or questions, the public hearing was closed, and the Committee proceeded to vote on the foregoing a ordinance as amended.

Report: *Assistant County Attorney Wifredo Ferrer read the foregoing proposed resolution into the record.*

Miami-Dade County Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz, appeared before the Committee in connection with the foregoing proposed resolution. He expressed concern regarding the \$200,000 reduction (from \$1,471,357.00 to \$1,271,357.00) in the purchase price for approximately 1.705 acres of vacant land for development of a branch library for the Miami-Dade Public Library System, located within the City of Hialeah Gardens. He noted this reduction would impact the City's budget for the children's sports programs and he asked that this proposed resolution reflect the initial purchase price of \$1,471,357.00. Commissioner Diaz pointed out that residents of the Town of Medley would also benefit from the proposed library.

In response to Commissioner Jordan's inquiry, Assistant County Manager Alex Munoz said staff received consideration on the price of the vacant property.

Pursuant to Commissioner Jordan's request, Assistant County Manager Munoz placed on the record the deals that were negotiated for development of a branch library in Pinecrest, Palmetto Bay, Killian and Hialeah Gardens. He said the County was paying approximately \$3.5 million for the Pinecrest library building and this

was a 30-year lease with two 30-year renewals; and \$3 million for the Palmetto Bay building which was a lease to own. Mr. Munoz noted the Killian branch library site was a new, private land purchase and was almost similar in size to the proposed Hialeah Gardens site. He pointed out the proposed Hialeah Gardens site was located in a library district and the public sector happened to own the land.

Mr. Raymond Santiago, Director, Miami-Dade Library Department, clarified that the Killian property was in the process of being purchased and this item would be coming before the County Commission. He assured the Committee members that the subject property in the foregoing proposed resolution was a good deal, noting this was a difficult area to identify suitable land. Mr. Santiago noted the property was located adjacent to a park and fulfilled many of the Department's missions.

Chairman Souto asked that during negotiations with the City of Hialeah regarding the proposed library, Assistant County Ferrer incorporate a provision within the contract between the City of Hialeah Gardens and Miami-Dade County that the safety and beauty of the general area (at least one quarter of a mile surrounding the library) must be kept to the highest County standard. He also asked Mr. Santiago to ensure that this provision was incorporated in contracts executed with any municipality.

Commissioner Jordan noted she had no problem with the vacant land being purchased at the initial price, if children's programs within the City of Hialeah would be impacted by the reduced price.

It was moved by Commissioner Jordan that the foregoing proposed resolution be amended to reflect the initial purchase price. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Edmonson.

In response to Commissioner Edmonson's inquiry regarding normal closing hours for libraries, Mr. Santiago said the closing time varied by day and the size of the libraries. He noted that libraries normally closed at 6:00 p.m., 8:00 p.m. or 9:00 p.m., and security was present at each library.

Chairman Souto emphasized the importance of safety for public facilities such as libraries and hospitals. He noted a clear message should be

conveyed to the cities that the County expected the highest level of security around libraries including illumination and patrolling.

Mr. Santiago said the libraries located within municipalities had established a close relationship with the police departments, and the Library Department's head of security met regularly with these police departments. He noted the departments were supportive of the libraries.

Assistant County Manager Munoz read the following language to be added on handwritten page three after the sentence relating to land acquisition in the Funding Sources section: "...Library Taxing District Dollars to be reimbursed at a subsequent bond sale." He noted this amendment related to the timing of funds and was not related to the City of Hialeah. Mr. Munoz said Library funds would be used to pay for the proposed library and these funds would be reimbursed by the General Obligation Bond funds.

Following discussion, the Committee by motion duly made, seconded and carried, voted to recommend that the foregoing proposed resolution be amended to approve a Contract for Sale and Purchase with the City of Hialeah Gardens and Miami-Dade County for approximately 1.705 acres of vacant land, for the initial purchase price of \$1,471,357.00, and the amendment noted by Assistant County Manager Munoz.

Mr. Larry Wilker, Interim President and Chief Executive Officer, Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Art Center (PAC), provided a status report of the PAC. He presented a brief video clip of the PAC'S summer activities which included Celia: The Life and Music of Celia Cruz; Miami Libre; and Slava's Snowshow. Mr. Wilker said approximately 130,000 patrons visited the PAC this summer, generating \$3.5 million in ticket sales with \$1 million in profits. He noted the PAC was responsible for more than 1,000 room nights at hotels in Miami-Dade County. Mr. Wilker said the PAC was an economic engine that provided year-round entertainment to the community.
