Stribild™, pronounced Stry – Build and abbreviated as (STB) is FDA approved and in retail pharmacies. Please be advised that the Florida ADAP does not have Stribild on its formulary at this time. At some point, we anticipate the drug will be available in the ADAP program.

Stribild™ is a combination product in one pill with an integrase strand transfer inhibitor (elvitegravir), and 2 nucleos(t)ide analog HIV-1 reverse transcriptase inhibitors (emtricitabine and tenofovir) indicated for use in adults who are antiretroviral treatment naive. This pill also contains a pharmacologic boosting agent (cobicistat) which does not have any anti-HIV activity.

Key points:

- Dosed one tablet once daily WITH Food
- 1 Contraindicated with drugs that:
- Are highly dependent on CYP3A for clearance as these drugs would have elevated plasma concentrations and could result in serious and/or life threatening adverse events
- 1 Strongly induce CYP3A which lowers STRIBILD which may cause loss of virologic response and possible resistance to develop
