WHERE TO APPLY

When open enrollment starts on October 1, 2013, you'll be able to use the www.healthcare.gov website to apply, compare plans and enroll.

- You can create your account ahead of time by pre-registering now
- Live online chat also available 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- New features include: mobile device, tablet, laptop or desktop computer

Call 1-800-318-2596 (TTY: 1-855-889-4325) you can call to get your Marketplace questions answered by a customer service representative also available 24/7.

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) – Specially-trained staff at FQHCs can provide education and assistance through **“Navigators.”** These include: Borinquen Medical Centers, Citrus Health Network, Community Health of South Florida, Inc., Jesse Trice Community Health Center and Miami Beach Community Health Center.
