ETHICS COMMISSION

TO: IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS of County employees seeking to accept Section 8 housing vouchers

Generally, an immediate family member (spouse, domestic partner, parents, stepparents, children, stepchildren) of a County employee may rent residences to tenants who receive Section 8 housing vouchers through the County if the employee of the immediate family members is not employed by the Miami-Dade County Public Housing and Community Development Department (PHCD). If an immediate family member of a County employee meets these requirements, written approval to become a Section 8 landlord must be obtained from the Ethics Commission.
