




Just in this last year...we had over 6 million visitors through our doors and over 4 million virtual visitors to our website.



Active library users checked out an average of 12 items last year. With an average of about \$25 per item, those 12 items would have cost each patron \$300.





The average number of eBooks checked out amongst our eBook users were 14 last year. That's a savings of \$210 a year if they were purchased through Amazon.




If you download 3 songs a week from Freegal, you would save over \$150 a year– the cost to purchase the songs through iTunes!

YOUmedia Miami

Engaging Teens Through Technology

YOUmedia Miami is a creative space for teens to experiment with digital media. It offers library-card-carrying students ages 14 to 19 a lab (or center) where they can learn about digital media and collaborate with other teens on projects ranging from animation, to video production to online journalism.

YOUmedia was started after Dennis Scholl and Jorge Martinez of the Knight Foundation visited YOUmedia Chicago in 2011 and approached our Director, Raymond Santiago about bringing the program to Miami. The Knight Foundation pledged over \$800,000.00 to renovate a space at the North Dade Regional Library, purchase equipment and support the program for its first two years.

Four certifications make up the core of the YOUmedia curriculum: an introduction to the space, basic digital photography, videography and music production. Once teens have completed the certifications, they move on to more structured workshops covering topics such as: photo editing, creating a literary magazine, spoken-word poetry, digital storytelling, music production, video production, animation and podcasting.

YOUmedia has been very successful in that the program has changed the way the library interacts with teens. Youth that previously never set foot in a library are now visiting daily! And the most frequently asked question is, "why isn't this at other libraries?" We're hoping to both expand the space at North Dade and bring the

Project L.E.A.D. (Literacy for Every Adult in Dade) is an adult literacy program designed to reach out to English speaking adults who are functionally illiterate and have reading and writing skills that are inadequate to cope with the demands of everyday life.

The Miami-Dade Public Library System offers two mobile libraries where you can borrow books, music, audio books and videos! Stops are scheduled at public parks, childcare facilities, condominium complexes, retirement communities, senior centers and recreational facilities.

Connections: Library Service for the Homebound provides books-by-mail service to individuals of all ages who are unable to visit the library in person due to chronic illness, physical disability and frailties of age.

The **Talking Books Library** loans Braille and audio books and magazines, along with a player, FREE by mail to persons who have difficulty reading or using printed books and other materials because of blindness, or visual, physical, or reading disabilities.

Jump Start is a “story time kit program to go” for all licensed preschool and kindergarten childcare centers. The kits contain all the tools to present fun, high quality story times on a variety of themes. Each kit includes books, finger plays, a flannel board story, a puppet, educational toy and a music CD.

The Permanent Art Collection & Vasari Project

The Miami-Dade Public Library System has a permanent art collection of more than 2,200 works of art. Our collection consists of works on paper, photographs, paintings, multiples, artists' books and small sculptures with a focus on African American, Latino, and Miami artists; national and international artists are also represented.

Additionally, the Vasari Project is an archive that documents the development of the visual arts in Miami-Dade County since 1945.

The Library System has a long history of cultural and educational exhibitions, and makes a special call to artists on a rolling basis for temporary exhibitions that correspond to selected annual themes and/or that highlight the library's special collections and services.
