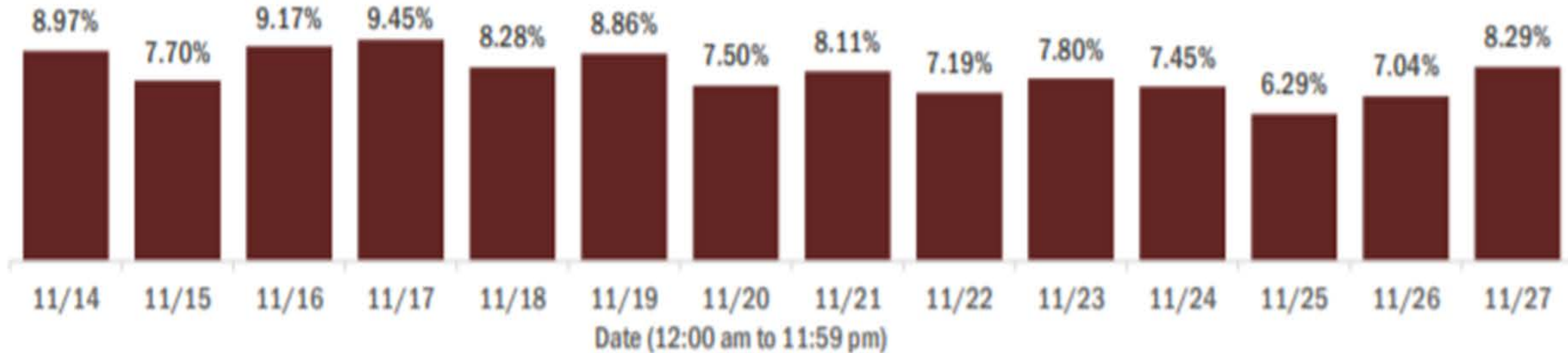
As of 7/30, there are 350 contact tracers in place (currently being updated)

COVID-19 Daily Positive Rate

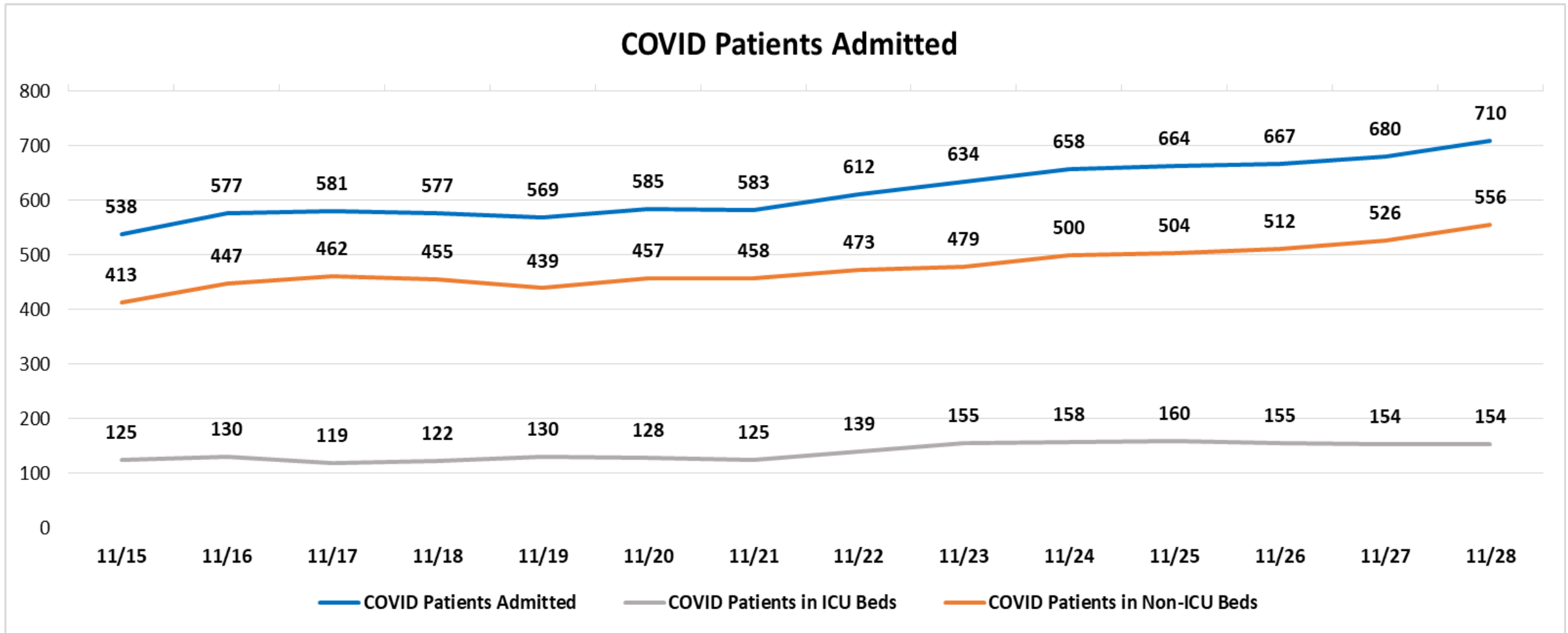
Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

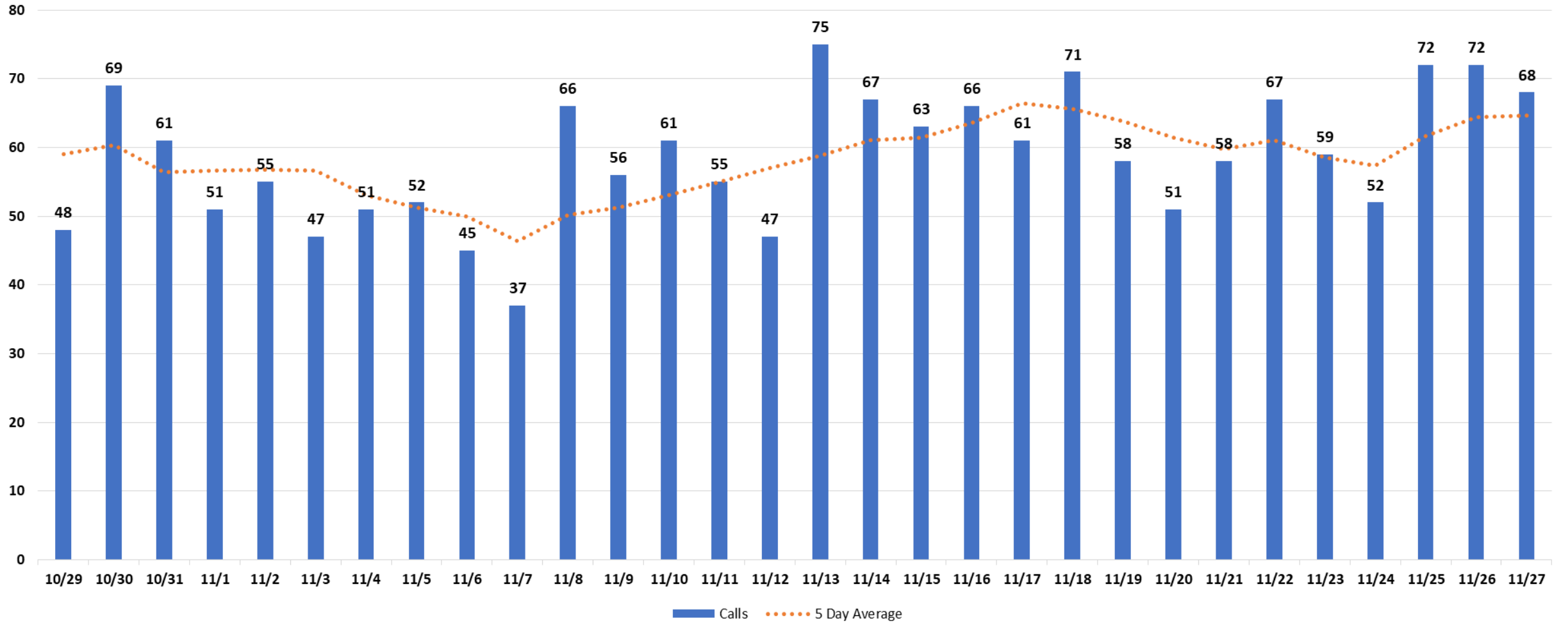
