#### For-Hire Chauffeur Applicants Frequently Asked Questions

# Do I need to take a class and exam to receive or renew my for-hire chauffeur license?

Yes, depending on the for-hire license. A course and exam is necessary for new and renewing drivers in the Jitney, Passenger Motor Carrier (PMC), Non-emergency, and Special Transportation Service industries (NE/STS). Renewing drivers take a for-hire chauffeur class every two to three years until they have had their for-hire chauffeur license for 20 consecutive years. Private School Bus drivers need to take the class initially to acquire their license. For-hire industries not mentioned do not need to take a class to acquire the for-hire chauffeur license.

**Note:** The PMC & NE/STS for-hire chauffeurs will need to demonstrate they speak and understand English to attend the class and acquire this license.

Section 31-303 (d) (a) of the Code states: As directed by the Department, which will ensure that the applicant is able to speak, read and write the English language sufficiently to perform the duties of a chauffeur; and passes the required Department oral and written exam demonstrating his or her knowledge of the English language, Miami-Dade County geography, traffic regulations, defensive driving techniques and chauffeur responsibilities.

### Is the for-hire chauffeur course and exam available on-line?

No, the for-hire chauffeur course and exam is not available on line. The class location is at 601 NW 1<sup>st</sup> Court, 18<sup>th</sup> Floor, Training Room 1855, Miami, FL 33136.



The registration fee will vary depending on the for-hire license you seek. The Private School Bus class is \$124.00 (including hack license and background check). Jitney, NE/STS, & PMC drivers pay \$94.00 for their hack license. Taxi and Limousine drivers are not required to take a class; their license fee is \$89.00.

# How many questions will be on the exam?

The exam is made-up of 50 multiple choice questions for Jitney; Passenger Motor Carrier; Non-Emergency/Special Transportation Services, and Private School Bus.



A passing grade is 70% or better.

#### How many questions can I miss on the exam and still pass?

You can miss up to 15 questions.

### How much time will I have to take the exam?

You will have 1.5 hours for the 50-question exam.

## Herefore the subjects will be covered on the exam?

Depending on the for-hire industry you work for, you may be tested on the following subjects: Americans with Disabilities Act, Customer Service, Miami-Dade County Code Rules and Regulations, Safety, and Geography.

# If I fail the exam, how many times can I take it again?

The average wait time is one week. There is a \$15 fee for each time you take the exam thereafter.

### Hen does the chauffeur license expire?

The chauffeur registration (hack) license expires on your birthday, either a year or two from the application date, depending on whether you paid for a one or two-year license.



You can renew your license up to 90 days prior to your birthday. This will keep your license from lapsing in service. It will also ensure on-time class scheduling, and avoid late fees. Drivers renewing their license after it has expired will pay a \$55 late fee and can receive a citation from an enforcement officer for driving with an expired chauffeur's registration license.
