
ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

THE MATTER came to be heard before this Court on June 18, 2009. The Court, after hearing legal argument of Counsel and reviewing all submitted documents, admitted evidence and taking Judicial Notice of Case No. 08-3787-CA-13, Norman Braman et al. vs. Miami-Dade County, Florida et al., makes the following findings:

- 1. Plaintiffs do have standing to bring this suit.**
- 2. This action is not barred by *res judicata*.**
- 3. The Plaintiffs did fail to join an indispensable party, The Florida Marlins.**
- 4. The procedure being utilized by the Defendants for sale of the subject bonds is not unconstitutional therefore the Series 2009 Refunding Bonds may be issued.**

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Injunction is hereby denied.
