



Population Demographics:


The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **84,584** and changed to **93,414** in 2010, representing a change of **10.4%**. The household count in 2011A was **95,370** and the household projection for 2016 is **102,623**, a change of **7.6%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **247,534** and in 2010 it was **259,382**, roughly a **4.8%** change. The population in 2011A was **263,621** and the projection for 2016 is **277,870** representing a change of **5.4%**.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33**, and in 2000, it was **35**. The median age in 2011A is **38** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39** years. In 2011A, females represented **50.1%** of the population with a median age of **40** and males represented **49.9%** of the population with a median age of **37** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15 to 19** years.




