


## Executive Summary with Charts

### Population Demographics:


The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **62,313** and changed to **62,734** in 2010, representing a change of **0.7%**. The household count in 2011A was **63,599** and the household projection for 2016 is **67,009**, a change of **5.4%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **196,663** and in 2010 it was **190,137**, roughly a **-3.3%** change. The population in 2011A was **191,850** and the projection for 2016 is **198,268** representing a change of **3.3%**.

### Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **30**, and in 2000, it was **32**. The median age in 2011A is **37** and it is predicted to change in five years to **38** years. In 2011A, females represented **52.2%** of the population with a median age of **39** and males represented **47.8%** of the population with a median age of **35** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.



In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **Black**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.


