

Population Demographics:


The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **64,407** and changed to **67,757** in 2010, representing a change of **5.2%**. The household count in 2011A was **66,598** and the household projection for 2016 is **68,249**, a change of **2.5%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **174,866** and in 2010 it was **188,939**, roughly a **8.0%** change. The population in 2011A was **186,080** and the projection for 2016 is **186,783** representing a change of **0.4%**.

Population by Age




In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **37**, and in 2000, it was **36**. The median age in 2011A is **38** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39** years. In 2011A, females represented **53.2%** of the population with a median age of **40** and males represented **46.8%** of the population with a median age of **37** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity




In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **Black**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.
