

Population Demographics:


The number of households in the study area in 2000 was **49,200** and changed to **51,432** in 2010, representing a change of **4.5%**. The household count in 2011A was **52,202** and the household projection for 2016 is **54,270**, a change of **4.0%**.

The population in the study area in 2000 was **146,342** and in 2010 it was **154,284**, roughly a **5.4%** change. The population in 2011A was **155,534** and the projection for 2016 is **159,037** representing a change of **2.3%**.

Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33**, and in 2000, it was **36**. The median age in 2011A is **38** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39** years. In 2011A, females represented **53.2%** of the population with a median age of **39** and males represented **46.8%** of the population with a median age of **36** years. In 2011A, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15 to 19** years.



In 2011A, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.


