**Subject:** Increase in Robberies in Westchester

---

Pursuant to your letter regarding the recent increase of robberies in the Westchester area, the Miami-Dade Police Department Midwest District personnel has been directed to address your concerns.

As a result, Midwest District personnel will:

- Provide crime analysis and intelligence information of robbery "hot spots" to platoon commanders for directed patrols by uniform patrol.
- Continue to initiate violent crime enforcement initiatives in identified "hot spots."
- Communicate and solicit assistance of Robbery Bureau personnel in addressing robbery related crime trends.
- Continue community outreach efforts to educate the public on crime prevention strategies.

As part of your inquiry, our investigation revealed that robberies in the Westchester area are down 12.5% and District 10 is down 18.54% year-to-date.
