I am pleased to report that Miami-Dade County received 31 National Association of Counties (NACo) Achievement Awards this year.

Since 1970, NACo has nationally recognized innovative county programs that improve service delivery to residents, achieve greater cost efficiency, help develop a better trained work force, and promote overall accountability. As indicated on the attached list of County winners, we are the recipient of awards for successfully implementing unique projects that are progressive and focus on responsible, effective government.

Achievement Award winners represent a cross-section of County programs and services, with several departments receiving multiple awards. The Miami-Dade Police Department received eight awards for programs in several areas including the crime analysis, RapidID and warrants on-line systems. The Information Technology Department received five awards including the GIS Oblique Imagery Implementation and GIS Voter Viewer Programs.
