Subject: Environmental Quality Control Board (EQCB) Reappointment of Dr. Claire M. Bradshaw-Sidran

As an active member of the Environmental Quality Control Board (EQCB) in good standing, Dr. Claire M. Bradshaw-Sidran has requested to be reappointed to the EQCB by the Board of County Commissioners (Board). Dr. Bradshaw-Sidran's current EQCB term expires December 15, 2012 and her resume is attached.

Because Dr. Bradshaw-Sidran has served continuously on the EQCB since 1974, she is exempt from term limits pursuant to Sec. 2-11.38.2(b) of the Code of Miami-Dade County. However, the Board must grant approval of her reappointment for each successive three (3) year term until she is replaced.

The EQCB is a quasi-judicial County board that rules on variance requests for highly scientific and technical matters under Chapter 24 of the Code of Miami-Dade County. The composition and membership of the EQCB requires advanced degrees and qualifications unique to environmental disciplines. Dr. Bradshaw-Sidran has served with distinction for many years and her service is greatly appreciated.
