Subject: Private Air Ambulance Airworthiness Certification

This report is provided in compliance with Resolution #R-1401-01 (December 18, 2001) which approved a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for a Private Air Ambulance Service provider: Miami Children's Hospital.

The resolution authorizing the Certificate was conditioned upon continued, annual demonstration of airworthiness as certified by the FAA or authorized FAA repair certicator. Miami Children's Hospital has submitted the requisite document (copy attached).

The Certificate is for hospital-based intra-county Miami-Dade County air ambulance transport service. Sixty-six (66) calls were reported for this service in calendar year 2012.


Dear Mr. Patino,

This letter confirms that all aircraft operated on Era Helicopters LLC operating certificate, UOGA290L, are in compliance with all applicable Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR), FAR 135.413. This regulation states that it is the certificate holder's responsibility to maintain the aircraft we operate in an airworthy condition. All aircraft listed in our Operation Specifications are in compliance with this FAR.

Specifically, the aircraft operated in and around Dade County, Florida, N15460 and N911GH, both Sikorsky S76's, are listed on the Era Helicopters LLC Operation Specifications.

In addition, each aircraft operated by Era Helicopters LLC displays an FAA issued Airworthiness Certificate in the cabin or cockpit entrance so that it is legible to all passengers or crew as required by the FAR 91.203.
