Subject: Report Regarding Circulator Maps Pre and Post-People's Transportation Plan

This report is provided in response to Commissioner Bruno Barriero's request at the November 16, 2012 Regional Transportation Committee meeting, for maps depicting those circulators that were approved as part of the original People's Transportation Plan (PTP), the increase in number of routes and the subsequent decrease number of circulator routes.

As shown on Attachment 1 and Map 1, there were eight Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) operated circulators which were approved as part of the original PTP via amendment (R-965-03) and began service between 2002 and 2004. These original 8 include: Little Haiti Connection, Coconut Grove Circulator, Little Havana Connection, Sweetwater Circulator, Flagami Connection, Liberty City Connection, Saga Bay/Goulds Connection and the Gratigny Connection.

Subsequent to the implementation of these original eight, an additional 11 circulators began service between 2003 and 2012 (see Attachment 1 and Map 2). They are: Gables Connection, Route 200, Route 344, South Beach Local, Route 82, Howard Killian Connection, Brownsville Circulator, Overtown Circulator, North Pointe Circulator, Mid-North Beach Connection, and the Cutler Bay Local.

Of these 19 routes, six have since been discontinued and one route was merged with another due to low ridership. Therefore, Map 3 depicts the 13 Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) circulators currently in operation.

Finally, it should be noted that the aforementioned circulators are those which MDT operates. According to the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT), there are a total of 26 circulators in operation that are funded with municipal Surtax dollars (Attachment 2), of which two are operated by MDT (Cutler Bay and Miami Beach).






