Dear Mayor Regalado:

When we met last Spring regarding several issues of mutual concern to the City of Miami (City) and Miami-Dade County (County), I committed to the completion of needed upgrades to the two sewer pump stations serving Coconut Grove by November 30, 2013.

I am pleased to report that the work has been completed and certified, and the moratorium on additional flows to the sewer system in the Coconut Grove area was officially lifted as of November 15th for Pump Station 9 and Pump Station 11. We are proceeding to put into place the resources necessary to address system constraints throughout the retail service area of the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department, with a goal of eliminating all existing moratorium areas and avoiding such conditions in the future. The cooperation from City staff in facilitating this work has been, and will continue to be, very important as we undertake critical capacity expansion and renewal projects in other areas of the City, including the Brickell and North Biscayne corridors.

I appreciate your cooperation in these efforts and look forward to building a stronger and more productive relationship between the City and the County.
