Subject: Services for Firefighter Steven English

On January 10, 2014, Firefighter Steven English passed away from injuries sustained in an off-duty motor vehicle accident. Firefighter English was a 19-year veteran with the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department. For most of his career, he worked in the busiest fire stations of the county. He also served as a MDR Driver Training Officer for four years.

Firefighter English was born in New York and raised in Georgia. Prior to joining the department, he proudly served in the U.S. Marine Corps and was honorably discharged. Firefighter English is survived by his daughter Ashley, his sons Taquon and Xavier, and a host of loved ones.

In his honor, flags at Fire Stations 21 and Fire Station 54 will remain at half-staff until sundown on Saturday, January 18, 2014.
