Subject: Proposed Charter Amendment Public Meetings

A proposed Charter amendment (Legistar 141255) regarding Article VII and to permit additional uses at Park facilities, sponsored by Commissioner Esteban Bovo, is tentatively scheduled for the Board of County Commissioners (Board) meeting on July 1, 2014. The item was first heard at the Cultural Affairs and Recreation Committee on June 9, 2014 where it was amended and forwarded with a favorable recommendation.
