**Subject:** Annual Report on Environmentally Contaminated Sites by Commission District  
through April 1, 2014

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On March 3, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. R-227-09, directing the County Mayor or his designee to prepare an annual report of environmentally contaminated sites by Commission District. The resolution is attached for reference.

The Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, Division of Environmental Resources Management, has prepared the Annual Report on Environmentally Contaminated Sites by Commission District identifying current and former contaminated sites through April 1, 2014.

Attached for distribution are 13 computer disks (one per Commission District) containing the annual reports consisting of two (2) maps per Commission District identifying current and former contaminated sites and two (2) summary tables per Commission District of site-specific information that correspond to the site identification numbers on the maps. Each disk is labeled with the appropriate Commission District number.

As required by Resolution No. R-227-09, I will continue to notify members of the Board with Notices of Environmental Contamination when contaminated sites are initially identified and confirmed within each Commission District.



RESOLUTION NO. R-227-09 \_\_\_\_\_

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NOTIFY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WHENEVER ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINATION IS IDENTIFIED IN A COMMISSIONER'S DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires that whenever environmental contamination is identified by the Department of Environmental Resources Management in Miami-Dade County that the Commissioner in whose district the environmental contamination is located shall be notified by the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that:

Section 1. This Board hereby directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee that whenever environmental contamination is identified by the Department of Environmental Resources Management ("DERM") in Miami-Dade County the Commissioner in whose district the environmental contamination is located shall be notified of such environmental contamination and the location of same not less than five (5) calendar days after such identification by DERM. Such notification shall be provided for sites which require site rehabilitation action pursuant to Division 3, Contaminated Site Cleanups, Chapter 24 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Section 2. In addition to the foregoing, this Board hereby directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to prepare an annual report for submission to this Board which sets forth the locations by Commission District and status of the environmental contamination of

all such sites in Miami-Dade County. The first such annual report shall be submitted to this Board not later than ten (10) calendar days after the date of passage of this Resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is the Economic Development and Human Services Committee. It was offered by Commissioner **Audrey M. Edmonson**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Barbara J. Jordan** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
