The following information is provided in response to your request for the types of calls-for-services for the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) Hammocks District Police Station, north of Kendall Drive (SW 8 Street - SW 88 Street), for calendar year 2014. The number of uniform police officers currently assigned per shift in the given area is as follows:

- Platoon One (Midnight Shift) – eight (8) sworn uniform personnel
- Platoon Two (Day Shift) - 11 sworn uniform personnel
- Platoon Three (Afternoon Shift) - 12 sworn uniform personnel

The total number of sworn uniform personnel in the given area is 31. In addition, there are five (5) sworn detectives assigned to investigate burglaries, auto thefts, and crimes against persons, 16 General Investigations Unit detectives, six (6) Neighborhood Resource Unit officers, and six (6) Priority Service Unit and Relief Squad officers that operate district-wide.
