Subject: The Underline Master Plan Public Meetings in District 5 and District 7

The Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces department and Miami-Dade Transit Department, in partnership with The Friends of the Underline, will be hosting three (3) public meetings for residents and business owners who live within a mile of this corridor for input on The Underline Master Plan. District 7 staff is welcome to attend these meetings.

The first opportunity for District 7 residents and business owners to participate will be on Thursday, April 16, 2015, from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. at the Jorge M. Perez Architecture Center's Korach Gallery at the University Of Miami School Of Architecture located at 1223 Theo Dickinson Drive, Coral Gables, Florida 33146. The focus of the meeting will be on the area below the Metrorail (the M-Path) from SW 57 Avenue (LeJeune Road) and US1 to the intersection of South Dixie Highway and Denicke Street).

The second opportunity for both District 5 and 7 residents and business owners to participate will be Friday, April 17, 2015, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. at the Miami-Dade Public Library System's Main Library Auditorium located at 101 West Flagler Street, Miami, FL 33130. The focus of the meeting will be on the area below Metrorail (the M-Path) from the Miami River to Southwest 26 Road.

The third opportunity to participate for both District 5 and 7 residents and business owners will be Saturday, April 18, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. at the Vizcaya Village and Garage located at 3280 South Miami Avenue, Miami, Florida on the Frost Museum of Science property. The focus of this meeting will be on the area below Metrorail (the M-Path) from Southwest 27 Road to LeJeune Road and US1.

All three (3) meetings are designed to gather feedback on opportunities and constraints, concerns, priorities, and ambitions for The Underline. The consultant, James Corner Field Operations, will guide this conversation through a series of thought-provoking questions and will summarize the feedback to inform the Framework Plan and Demonstration Projects' scope, as well as set key priorities in collaboration with the community. The consultant, along with County staff, will answer questions about The Underline Master Plan.
