Subject: Parking Spaces for Young Children and Stroller Fees Revenue Distribution

Pursuant to Resolution R-123-13 approved by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) on February 5, 2013, one-third of the allocable portion of fees collected by the County for parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers will be distributed to each commission district.

More specifically, Implementing Order 4-100 provides that each time the allocable portion on deposit in the funds of the County equals \$130,000, \$10,000 of such amount shall be apportioned to each commission district for allocation. The fund has now met the threshold required; therefore, the Board is now able to allocate up to \$10,000 by district. These allocations may be made by motion or resolution approved by the Board and must be distributed to private, not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies that provide services for severely abused or neglected children.
