**Subject:** Deployment of Additional Police Officers

The attached plan is provided to you in response to your September 18, 2015 memorandum regarding Miami-Dade Police Department's (MDPD) plan to deploy an additional 100 police officers during Fiscal Year 2015-16. In addition, you requested that the plan include: population, density, call volume, and category of crimes in a particular geographic areas. Since the receipt of your request, MDPD was awarded a three-year, \$3,125,000.00 grant under the 2015 COPS Hiring Program by the United States Department of Justice. This grant will allow MDPD to hire 25 additional officers, bringing the total number to 125 additional police officers.

In regards to the deployment of additional police officers, MDPD considers many factors when making decisions regarding the deployment of sworn personnel. These factors include geography, population, severity of crime, calls for service (type and volume), response times, and attrition rates. At this time, MDPD is still conducting an assessment of the staffing levels and service needs at all police district stations. MDPD is keenly aware of the population growth that southwest Miami-Dade County has experienced and intends to address those needs in the ongoing deployments of sworn personnel.





## All Crimes 2014 and YTD 2015 MDPD Police Districts





## Compmat Targeted Crimes 2014 and YTD 2015 MDPPD Police Districts





## Part 1 Crimes 2014 and YTD 2015 MDPD Police Districts




