

**Subject:** Report on Aesthetics of PROS Vehicles (Resolution R-604-15) – Directive 151152

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At the June 30, 2015 Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners (Board) meeting, the Board approved Resolution R-604-15 (Attachment 1) directing the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to:

- a) Within budgeted funds, maintain County vehicles and heavy equipment used in public areas of Miami-Dade County parks in a manner that does not detract from the scenic beauty of the County's parks, and, at a minimum, ensure that County vehicles and heavy equipment used in public areas of the parks are free of visible rust or paint-job damage, such as faded paint; and
- b) Prepare a report to the Board on the implementation of the above directive, and, if the Administration is unable to fully implement the directive within budgeted funds, then to advise the Board of the extent the directive can be accomplished within budgeted funds and what additional funding is needed to fully implement the directive.

The Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) used the assumptions below to begin its review of PROS vehicles in its inventory:

1. Assess the state of PROS vehicles only, even though various other County departments operate on PROS facilities (e.g. Water and Sewer, Public Works and Waste Management, Miami-Dade Police, and Regulatory and Economic Resources).
2. Include on-road and off-road vehicles and equipment that work in or are stored/parked in publicly visible areas, especially if they display the County logo.
3. Exclude on-road vehicles operated and stored out of publicly visible areas, such as service roads behind Zoo Miami; excluding off-road light fleet, heavy fleet, mowers, tractors, and other riding equipment not stored in public view whose function intrinsically involves cutting vegetation, moving soil/sand, or similar activity, especially if the vehicle or equipment does not display a County logo.
4. Include any vehicle showing clear signs of visible rust or paint-job damage, such as faded paint.

PROS then surveyed park staff, observed County vehicles in areas of high public traffic, reviewed its capital inventory, and conducted visual inspections. Based on this effort, PROS identified 132 vehicles displaying signs of rust or paint damage (Attachment 2).

Upon completing the initial list, the age and mileage of these vehicles became apparent. Since then, PROS has met with the Office of Management and Budget, Internal Services Department, and Finance Department. Based on those meetings, PROS recommends developing a formal vehicle replacement program, prioritizing these 132 vehicles based on their operational condition. In an attempt to accelerate aesthetics, PROS will recommend painting/refurbishing any vehicle that the program cannot replace within three (3) years. Any cases of extreme deterioration will be addressed immediately using budget revenues. PROS anticipates recommending the program through the FY 2016-17 budget process;

In accordance with Ordinance 14-65, this memorandum will be placed on the next available Board of County Commissioners meeting agenda.



RESOLUTION NO.      R-604-15

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO MAINTAIN COUNTY VEHICLES AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT USED IN PUBLIC AREAS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PARKS WITHIN BUDGETED FUNDS IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT DETRACT FROM THE SCENIC BEAUTY OF THE COUNTY'S PARKS; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE BOARD ON THE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BOARD'S DIRECTIVE TO ADEQUATELY MAINTAIN COUNTY VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT USED IN PUBLIC AREAS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PARKS

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County owns and, through its Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department, operates 260 parks throughout the County, which are visited daily by County residents and visitors from around the world; and

WHEREAS, poorly maintained County vehicles and heavy equipment (e.g., tractors, excavators, and similar equipment) that show rust damage or need repainting detract from the scenic beauty of the County's parks and project a negative image of the County's operations; and

WHEREAS, the County's park patrons desire and deserve to fully enjoy the scenic beauty of County parks as unblemished by poorly maintained County vehicles and heavy equipment; and

WHEREAS, this Board has previously expressed, through Resolution No. R-242-08, that County vehicles "should be kept clean and in good repair in order to promote a professional image on behalf of the County," and many years later continues to desire that County vehicles and heavy equipment be adequately maintained so as to enhance park patrons' experiences and promote a favorable impression amongst park patrons of the County's stewardship of tax dollars and public resources,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

**Section 1.** The County Mayor or Mayor's designee is directed, within budgeted funds, to maintain County vehicles and heavy equipment used in public areas of Miami-Dade County parks in a manner that does not detract from the scenic beauty of the County's parks. At a minimum, the County Mayor or Mayor's designee shall ensure that County vehicles and heavy equipment used in public areas of the parks are free of visible rust or paint-job damage, such as faded paint.

**Section 2.** The County Mayor or Mayor's designee shall prepare a report to the Board on its implementation of the directive set forth in Section 1. To the extent the County Mayor or Mayor's designee are unable to fully implement the directive set forth in Section 1 within budgeted funds, the County Mayor or Mayor's designee's report shall advise this Board of the extent to which the directive can be accomplished within budgeted funds and what additional funding is necessary to fully implement the directive. The County Mayor or Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
