REQUIREMENTS WHICH MUST BE AGREED UPON PRIOR TO INSPECTION

An inspection will be performed by the fire prevention inspector. A permit will not be issued without an approved inspection of the burn site performed by the Fire Prevention Division (786-331-4800). A check/money order must be included with the application for burn permit. **An inspection will not be conducted until payment is rendered.** (A pre-inspection is required prior to issuance of any burn permit)

NOTE: Please check all applicable areas. All items relating to each applicable section must be complied with to obtain **and retain** a permit. Additional fees will be imposed if additional inspections are required.

GENERAL

- There will be no burning of residential trash, garbage, construction debris, leaves, cuttings, yard trimmings, copper wire, tree stumps, plastic, pallets, etc.
- There are no plastics mixed with the vegetation to be burned
- There will be no debris transported into any burn site
- The Fire Communication Office (786-268-6635) will be called each day prior to burning for approval
- Burning will not begin until after 9:00 AM
- There will be no visible signs of combustion by 5:00 pm (except approved bonfires)
- All reasonable precautions will be taken to prevent excessive visible emissions and odors (public nuisance) during burning
- Burning will only take place when wind direction and speed will not adversely affect visibility of public roads (smoke)
- All required equipment and water supplies will be on site and operational for the duration of the burn
- The burn will be supervised and constantly attended
- The burn permit will be kept on the burn site while burning

BONFIRES

- All public roads are at least one hundred (100) feet away from burn site
- All occupied buildings are at least three hundred (300) feet away from burn site
- Pile size will not be greater than five(5) feet high, long, or wide
- No utility lines are located overhead

POLYETHYLENE MULCH PLASTIC BURNING

- All occupied buildings are at least three hundred (300) feet away from burn site
- All public roads are at least one hundred (100) feet away from burn site
- Vegetation has been cleared around piles
- Pile sizes are not greater than five (5) feet high, long, or wide
- Documentation supporting polyethylene string material composition will be available upon request if the string is to be burned with the polyethylene mulch plastic

LAND CLEARING BURNING

- All occupied buildings are at least three hundred (300) feet away from burn site (exception: When using an air curtain incinerator, occupied buildings will be at least two hundred (200) feet away)
- All public roads are at least three hundred (300) feet away from burn site (exception): When using an air curtain incinerator, public roads will be at least one hundred (100) feet away)
- Vegetation has been cleared around piles
- Pile sizes are not greater than twenty (20) feet high, long, or wide
- Piles are spaced at least fifty (50) feet apart

AIR CURTAIN INCINERATION BURNING

- The pit dimensions are 8-15 feet deep, no more than 12 feet wide, and no longer than the length of the manifold
- The materials to be burned are only trees, logs, large brush, stumps free of soil, and approved vegetative trash
- Waste oil, chemicals, and gasoline will not be used to start or maintain burning
- Material to be burned will not protrude above the air curtain
- The air curtain incinerator will have a Miami-Dade DERM permit (exception: under 30 calendar days of burning)

PLEASE NOTE: Failure to comply with above conditions/rules will result in a citation or revocation of burn permit and forfeiture of fees.
