



This course will introduce the student to the mathematical theory behind the formulas used to determine the origin of blood sources and the scientific principals that dictate the motion of blood. Completion of this course will enable the student to analyze, interpret, and testify more effectively in cases where bloodstain analysis is performed.

Prerequisite: attendance / completion of a (40) hour bloodstain pattern analysis workshop

The course is designed to teach experienced operators the advanced skills required to function and meet the high demands placed on the modern day police snipers.

This 40-hour hands on course is designed to provide students with the necessary tools, tactics, and techniques to provide the most comprehensive protection to dignitaries in their care. Amongst the topics covered in this course will be the philosophy and responsibilities of a protective detail, advance procedures (Intel analysis, site surveys, route planning, etc.), site security, protective escorts (formations, small room tactics, stairwell tactics, etc.), motorcade operations, and evacuation and counter assault tactics. These methods are based on the United States Secret Service model, with an emphasis on local law enforcement's role in protective security details. Students need to bring their duty weapon(s) for live fire exercises (ammunition will be provided). The course will also include driving techniques (rental vehicles will be provided), as well as Simunition force-on-force scenarios. This training is only available to law enforcement and active military personnel.

CARGO THEFT SEMINAR

DATE: APRIL 1 - 4

FEE: \$651

LOCATION: NEWPORT BEACHSIDE RESORT COST: \$139 SINGLE / DOUBLE

This 4-day course has been designed to meet the demands placed on the modern-day cargo theft police investigator or industry security specialist. Experts in each field will discuss the various investigative strategies used by law enforcement and loss prevention professionals to combat cargo theft. Instructors with decades of experience in their respective areas will provide detailed instruction with practical application formats useful to the investigator on the street. Cutting edge initiatives will be discussed and presentations will be offered, including a review of some "tools of the trade." This course will provide the line investigator with valuable ideas and strategies that have been employed successfully by the TOMCATS and other law enforcement groups dedicated to cargo theft investigations. The course will also provide insight for task force managers on the procedure used to develop and maintain a multi-agency initiative investigating both state and federal violations of law.

UNDERWATER POLICE SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

DATE: MAY 5 - 16

FEE: \$890

LOCATION: MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING INSTITUTE

ACCOMODATIONS : COURTYARD BY MARRIOT MIAMI WEST

COST: \$100 SINGLE / DOUBLE

This 2-week course is open to all levels of law enforcement officers and fire service personnel. Students must hold a current Advanced Open Water Diver rating to apply (proof required prior to course registration). The course will combine classroom instruction with practical in-water application. The student will participate in the removal of vehicles from lakes, rock pits, and canals. Students will also search the hull of a freighter at the Port of Miami and participate in helocasting exercises. The student will be exposed to underwater search and recovery, underwater video and photography, underwater crime scene processing and the use of underwater lift bags. *This class is eligible for salary incentive money for Florida officers.*

TECHNICAL OPERATIONS & COVERT TACTICS WORKSHOP

DATE: MAY 26 - 30

FEE: \$759

LOCATION: MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING INSTITUTE

ACCOMODATIONS : COURTYARD BY MARRIOT MIAMI WEST

COST: \$100 SINGLE / DOUBLE

This is a 40-hr course that is geared to law enforcement personnel specifically assigned in the use, installation and maintenance of specialized electronic equipment for evidence gathering. Experts in the field will discuss basic laws, techniques and equipment utilized in audio and video surveillance. Also covered will be the use of tracking devices, covert entry of vehicles and structures pursuant to a court order. The course will also show investigators how to put together video equipment and install in a covert environment. Included with tuition students will receive a kit comprised of board camera, power supply, necessary wiring, and connectors required to complete the course.

CRIMINAL STREET GANGS INVESTIGATIONS

In addition to classroom presentations, the student will also be taken out on location and participate in a real gang operation, in Miami-Dade County.

This week long course consisting of lecture and practical applications provides the student with detailed instruction on the duties and responsibilities of the Honor Guard.


