BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

FACT SHEET

A Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) was created by the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Governing Board for the Miami Urbanized Area in 1984, as a subcommittee of the Citizens Transportation Advisory Committee. In 1985, the BAC was made a separate committee. In the 1990's, the committee took-on pedestrian issues as the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC).

Currently, the BPAC consists of 14 (out of a possible 23) citizens to advise the MPO Governing Board on bicycle and pedestrian-related issues within Miami-Dade County. Each MPO Board voting member has one appointment to the BPAC. The term for each appointee is at the discretion of the appointing MPO Governing Board Member.

The purposes of the BPAC are to:

- Provide information to and assist the MPO staff with development of an acceptable comprehensive community bicycle transportation plan, which will be appended to the Long-Range Transportation Plan; and
- Advise the MPO Governing Board on matters relating to bicycling and walking.

The main functions of the BPAC are to:

- Assist in the development of Bicycle and Pedestrian Plans.
- Review transportation plans and projects for bicycle and pedestrian mobility.
- Review the Miami-Dade County Long-Range Transportation Plan and the Transportation Improvement Program.
