

MPO RESOLUTION #28-08

RESOLUTION APPROVING PROJECTS IDENTIFIED AS REGIONAL PRIORITIES IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) DISTRICT 6 FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE FYs 2010-2012 TRANSPORTATION REGIONAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement creating and establishing the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Miami Urbanized Area requires that the MPO provide a structure to evaluate the adequacy of the transportation planning and programming process; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Planning Council (TPC) has been established and charged with the responsibility and duty of fulfilling the aforementioned functions; and

WHEREAS, the TPC has reviewed the identified regional priorities projects in Miami-Dade County, made a part hereof, and finds it consistent with the goals and objectives of the Transportation Plan for the Miami Urbanized Area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE MIAMI URBANIZED AREA, that the attached projects identified as regional priorities in Miami-Dade County to be submitted to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 6 for consideration under the FYs 2010-2012 Transportation Regional Incentive Program is hereby approved.
