

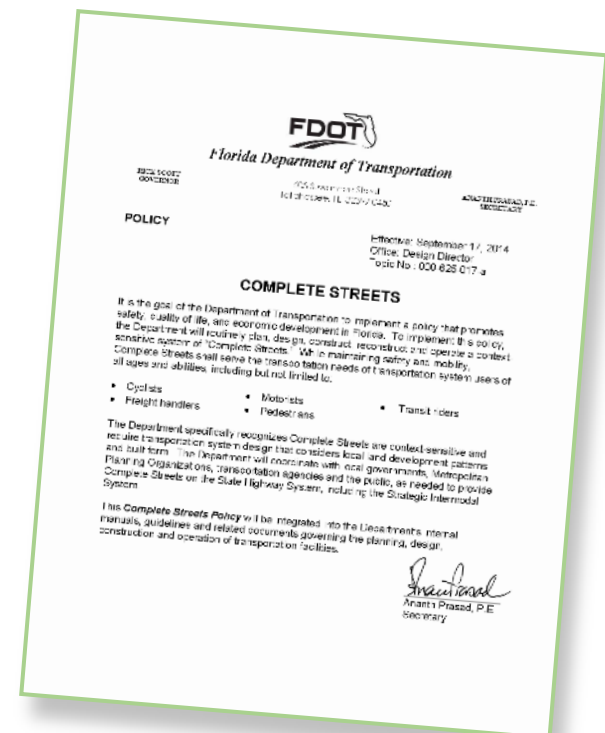

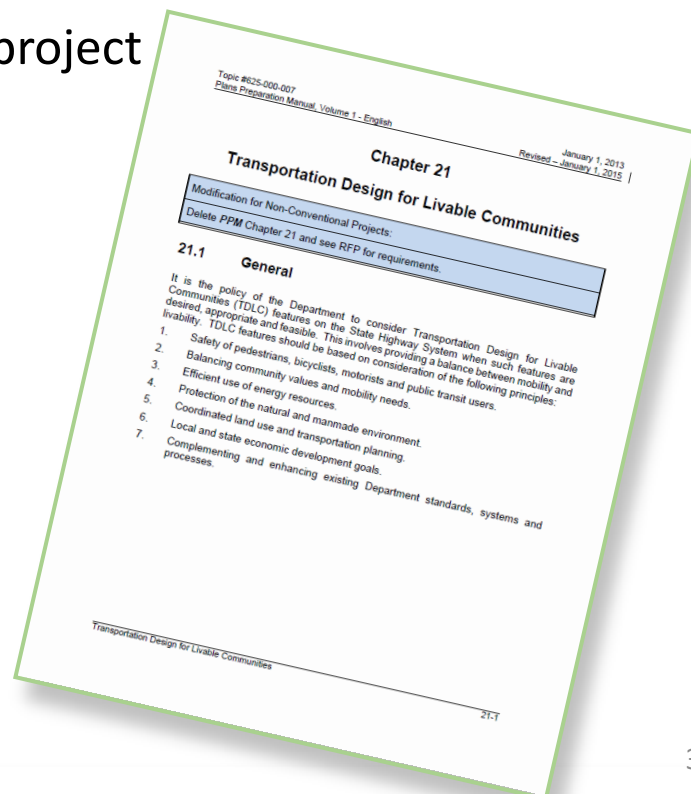
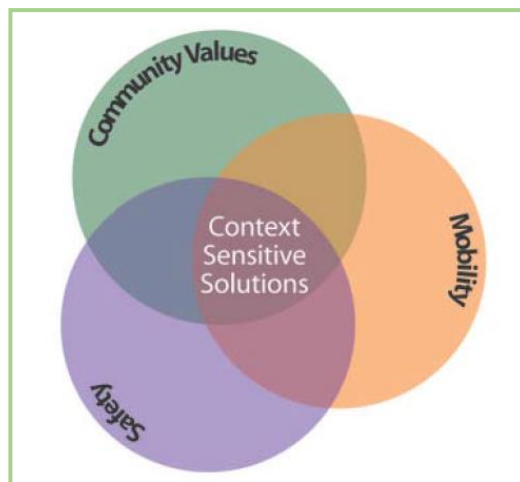
Complete Streets Policy

- ▶ Promote safety, quality of life, and economic development in Florida
- ▶ Plan, design, construct, reconstruct and operate a context-sensitive system of “Complete Streets”
- ▶ Serve the transportation needs of all system users of all ages and abilities
- ▶ Considers local land development patterns and built form
- ▶ Coordinate with local governments, MPOs, transportation agencies, and the public

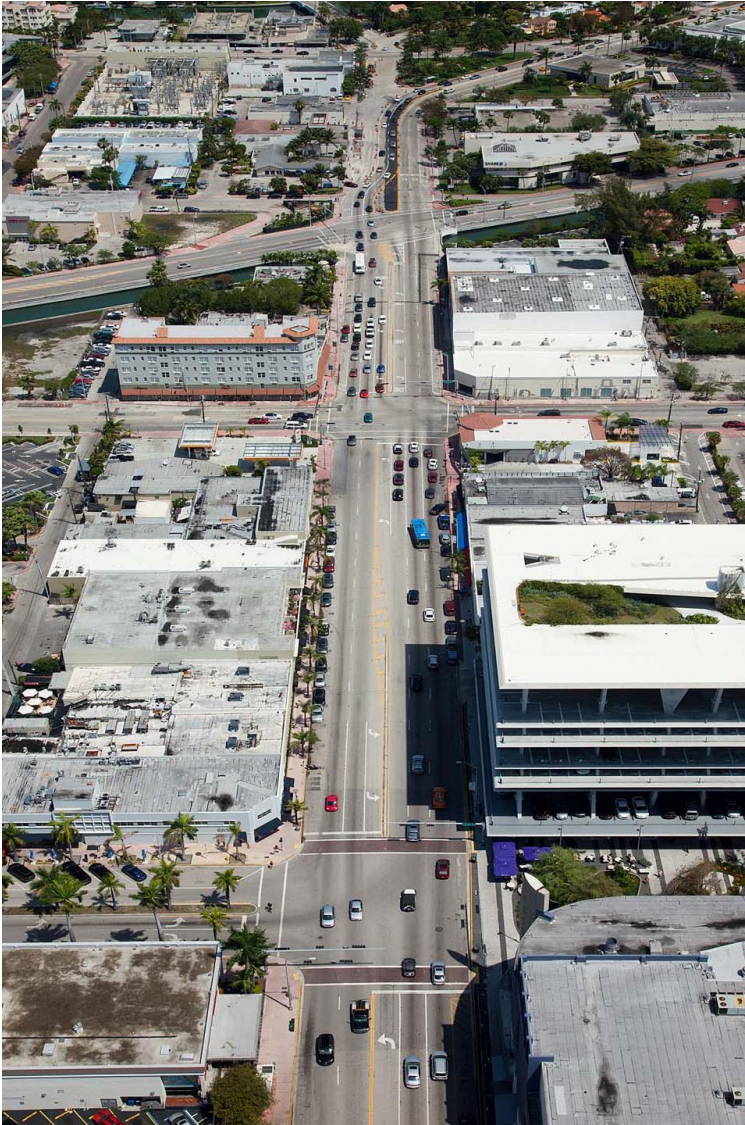


Complete Streets Policy History

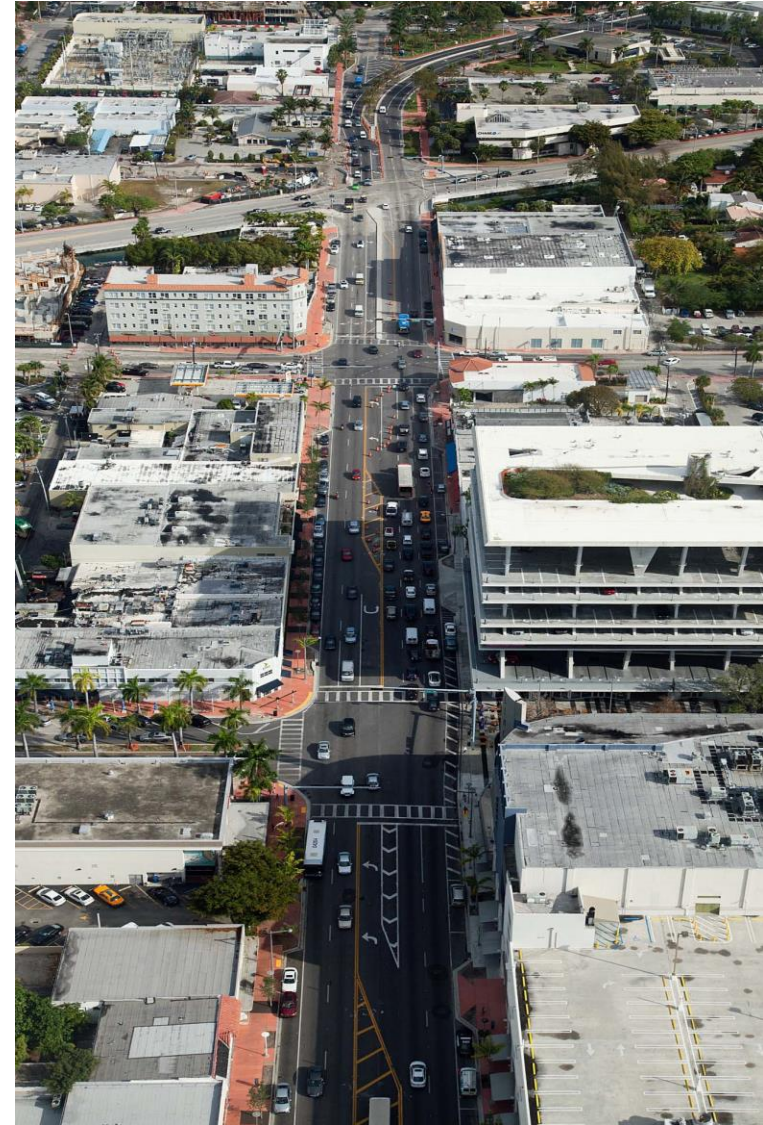
- ▶ Transportation Design Through Liveable Communities (TDLC) – 1998
 - Allows for more flexibility in design standards for urban areas
 - Process for communities to become TDLC designated areas
- ▶ Context Sensitive Solutions (CSS) Policy – 2008
 - Considered the physical setting in which a project or activity is to be implemented
- ▶ Complete Streets Policy - 2014

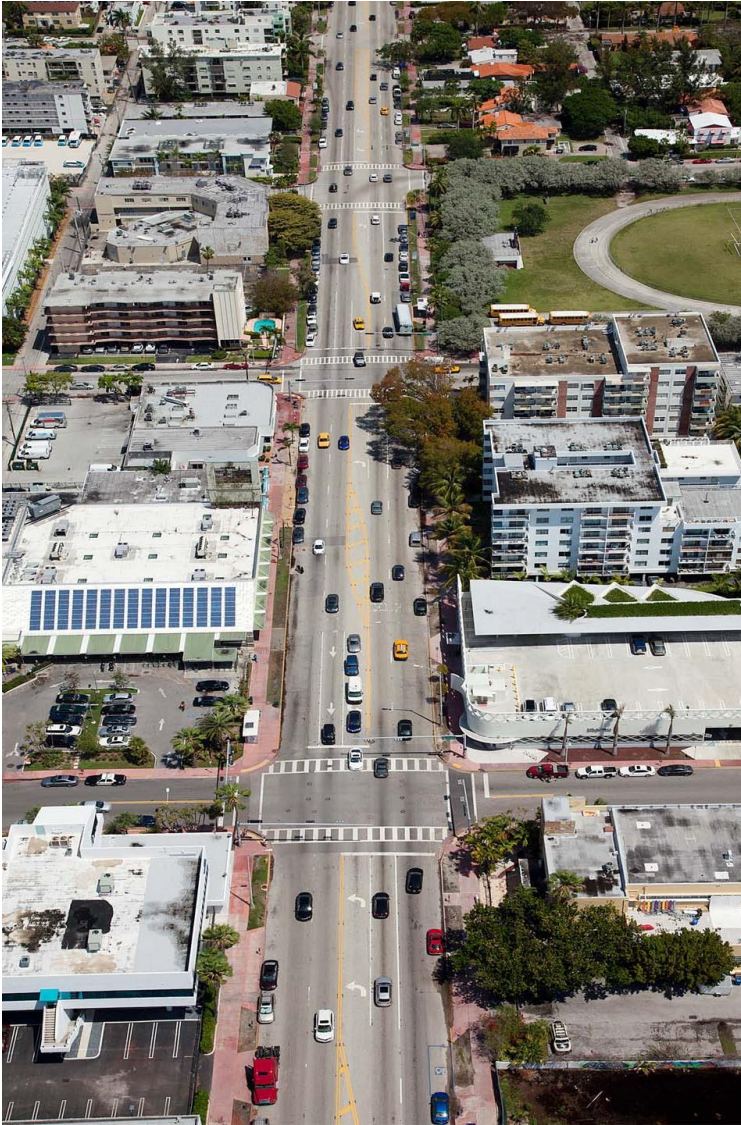

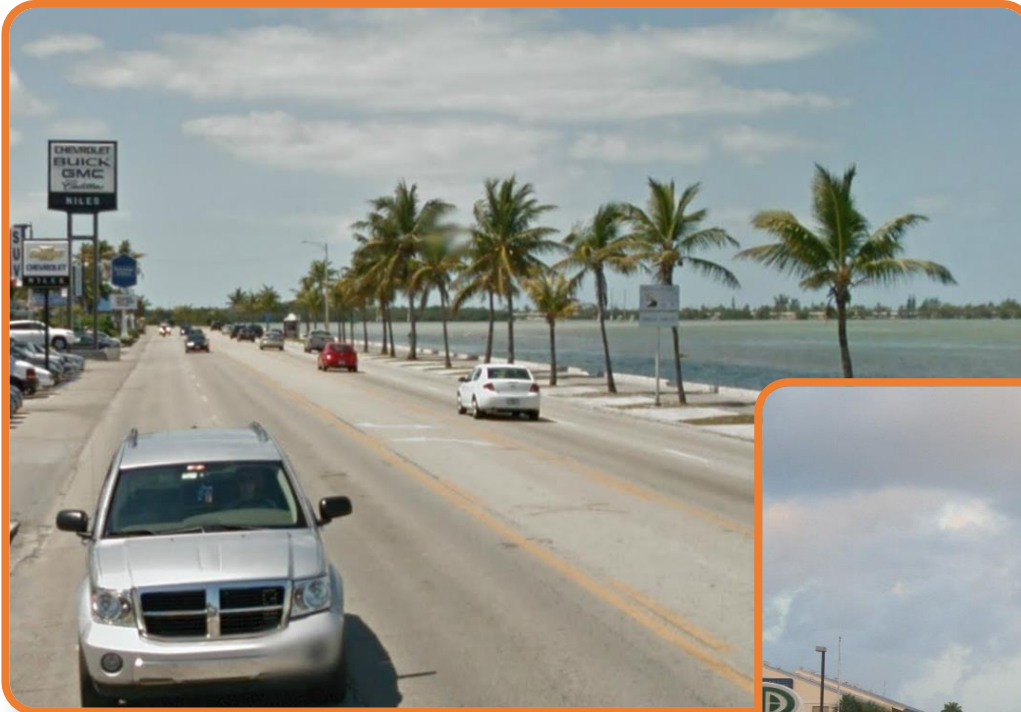

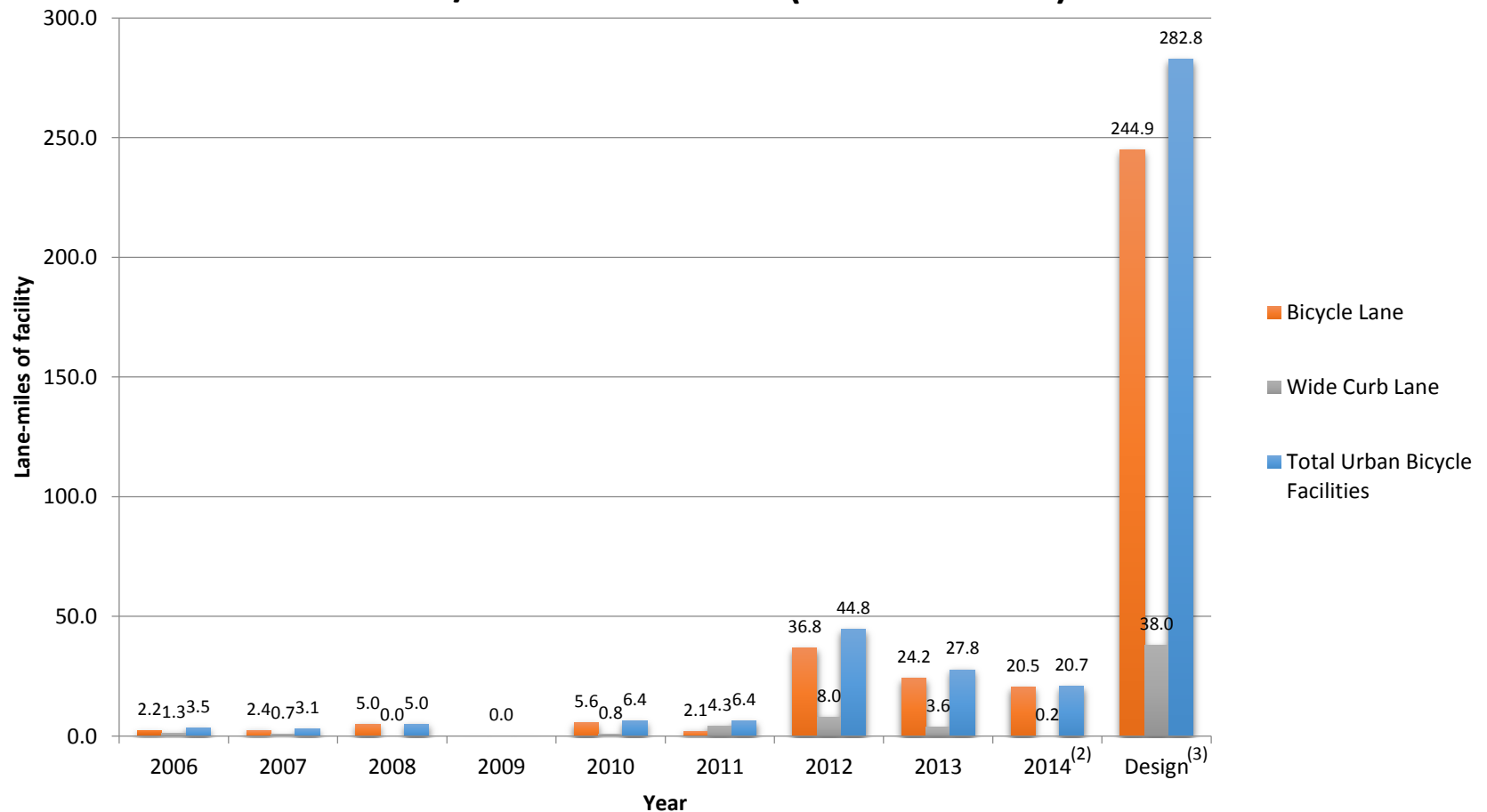

Urban Bicycle Facilities Installed in FDOT District 6 Miami-Dade/Monroe Counties (2006 - Present)



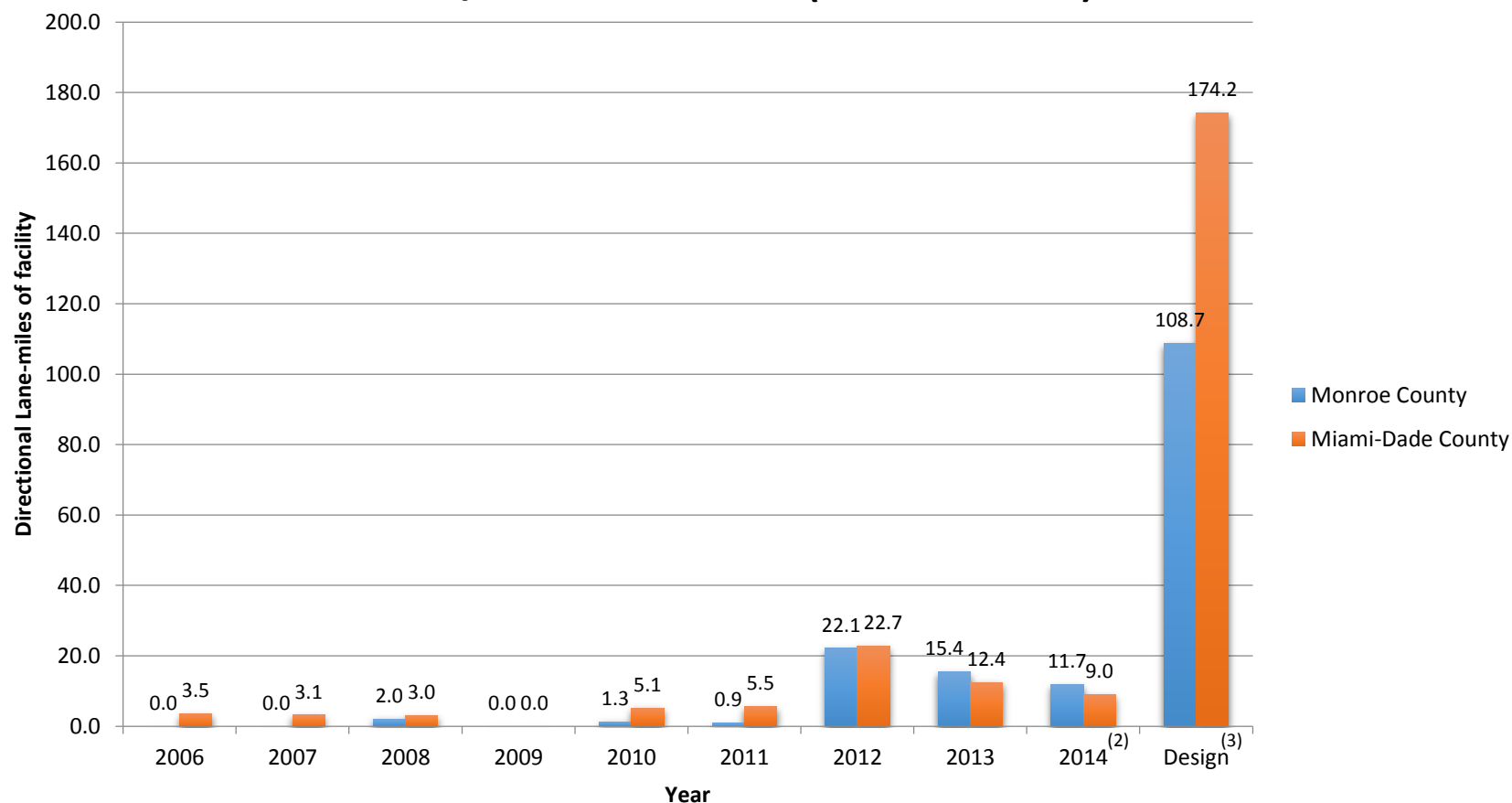
