Build New Neighborhood Parks

...for our children and families to play in close to home.

Protect the Heritage of Our Park System

...and restore our older historic parks like Greynolds, Haulover, Matheson Hammock and Homestead Bayfront.

Refurbish Our Beaches

...and protect the wonderful seascapes that enhance the quality of our lives and the experiences of those that visit Miami-Dade County.

Preserve Our Natural Areas

...and protect our coastal areas, wetlands, pinelands and wildlife areas from future development.

Conserve Our Open Space

...and save the agricultural and rural lands from development.

Enhance Our Regional Parks

...and complete facilities at Tropical Park, Tamiami Park and Amelia Earhart Park while developing our new acquisitions such as West Kendall District Park, Ives Estates District Park and Homestead Air Reserve Park.
