



This western view captures several important site features proposed for Camp Matecumbe. The most prominent and project-defining proposed site feature displayed in this perspective view is the reforestation of the Pine Rockland into the Camp Matecumbe Site, using the surrounding Pine Rockland Preserve as a model for reestablishment.

Four overnight cabins are envisioned to be tucked within the newly established Pine Rockland vegetation, as shown in this perspective's foreground. Within this foreground, one of many proposed eco-friendly trails that intertwine and connect the Camp Matecumbe Site with the surrounding Pine Rockland preserve trail system and surrounding residential neighborhoods can be observed. An open and active recreational green space used by overnight campers and park visitors is shown in the background. The renovated Gym, a multifunctional building set in a unique and exciting atmosphere, can be used for internal park and external public assemblies and functions.



This northern view illustrates the Native Pine Rockland Garden and Seedling Center. These gardens are the first of many visual and ecologically based features visitors discover within the park. These gardens are located in the foreground of the proposed learning center between the entry drive and the community playground.

The Native Pine Rockland Reservation Garden/Native Seedling Garden was envisioned to be a multi-functional community friendly space consisting of an interactive area that allows visitors to "get involved", and "get their hands dirty" in the restoration of the Boystown Pineland. These gardens will also function as a teaching tool for school programs and summer camps. It can also serve as a place where the local community comes and purchases native plants for personal use.
