# Ride the Rickenbacker




**Saturday, January 10, 2009**

The Rickenbacker Causeway and Crandon Boulevard will have one side of the road closed to traffic (cars, trucks and motorcycles will be diverted to other side of the causeway) so that bicyclists, rollerbladers and pedestrians can enjoy the dedication ceremony and have an awesome ride on the causeway.



- 5 miles of the Rickenbacker will be traffic free for cyclists to enjoy.

- Bicycle advocacy groups will be on-hand with information, clinics and displays.

- \$1.50 causeway toll applies to those who choose to drive to ride.
- Parking at Crandon Park is FREE for folks with bicycles until noon.
- No Registration is necessary just show up and have fun.
