About In the Company of Women

For 27 years, In the Company of Women has been recognizing the accomplishments of women in all professions throughout Miami-Dade County. The event began in 1989 as a means to unite and pay tribute to women from diverse backgrounds, and to this day continues to acknowledge women from all walks of life who demonstrate leadership, vision and responsibility to the community.

Timed to coincide with national Women's History Month, In the Company of Women has been recognized by the National Association of Counties and the Southern Region of the U.S. Civil Rights Commission. Past awardees have included salsa legend Celia Cruz, U.S. Congresswomen Ileana Ros-Lehtinen, Frederica Wilson and Debbie Wasserman Schultz, philanthropist Adrienne Arsht and Grammy award-winning recording artist Gloria Estefan, as well as other women who have made enduring contributions in Miami-Dade.

With support from The Parks Foundation of Miami-Dade, In the Company of Women is also helping to develop future female leaders, by providing lasting support to Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces, including the Women's Park and GEM (Girls Empowerment and Mentoring) Program.

History of Women's Park

Women's Park began as the dream of feminist Roxcy O'Neal Bolton, who envisioned a park and history gallery in honor of the women of Miami-Dade County and their diverse contributions to improving our community's quality of life. Dedicated in 1992, it is the first such park in the United States, serving as a model to the nation.

The 15-acre lakeside park, located at 10251 West Flagler Street, features displays depicting women's history and achievements. Space is provided for meetings, cultural events, and shows. The Women's Park also includes a children's playground and picnic pavilion.

The Women's Park is dedicated to all women in Miami-Dade County in recognition of their diverse contributions to improving our community's quality of life.

2015 Awards Ceremony

In the Company of Women awardees are selected in December 2014 by a panel of community leaders organized by the Miami-Dade County Commission for Women. Winners will be recognized at an awards ceremony and cocktail reception on Thursday, March 5th, 2015, beginning at 6:00 p.m.
