
Neighborhoods

Satisfaction with the overall appearance of Miami-Dade County




More residents say they are very satisfied/satisfied with the appearance of Miami-Dade County.



- Fifty-one percent of those surveyed said they were satisfied or very satisfied with the smoothness of County roads compared to **38 percent** in 2003.
- Residents rated drainage improvements to prevent street flooding as a top priority for their neighborhoods. The County will clean up to 11,000 storm drains and clear aquatic debris and vegetation from 168 miles of secondary drainage canals four times this year. Recently completed canal bank stabilization and culvert replacement projects will also improve drainage along with the installation of more than 189 miles of storm drainpipes and 18,000 drainage structures.





The Department of Environmental Resources Management's Adopt-a-Tree Program seeks to replenish the County's urban tree canopy and beautify neighborhoods. The program provided **20,762** free trees compared to **19,878** the previous year.
