

Mayor's Advisory Group:
Historic Preservation Ordinance

Make-up of the Historic Preservation Board

CURRENT LANGUAGE

The Board shall consist of thirteen (13) members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners should attempt to appoint architects, realtors, archeologists, historians, art historians, lawyers or other individuals from the business, financial and other segments of the community who, by virtue of their profession or business, have demonstrated concern for historic preservation. The Historic Preservation Board shall contain not less than one architect; one real estate agent or attorney at law; and one historian or architectural historian. The term of office of membership shall be four (4) years for each member.

STAFF-PROPOSED CHANGES

- Adding archaeologists and engineers to the list of professions that should be appointed to the Board
- Adding language that Chair is to be elected annually
- Adding language that Chair shall serve no more than 2 consecutive terms
