The public and agency employees are also invited to offer comments to the assessment team by calling (305) 627-7105, on Monday, August 12, 2013, between the hours of **1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.** Telephone comments and appearances at the Public Information Session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
